## COVID-19 Precaution Advice

This guidance has been created based on advice from central government. In order to keep the driver and his passengers safe, during this COVID-19 crises whilst travelling in the wedding car. It is essential Fabulous Cars is promoting a safe space. These safety measures introduced are ways we must adhere to in order to go about our every day way of life safely but conveniently.

In order to achieve this objective, please adhere to these simple and sensible steps at all times whilst travelling in our wedding car -

- On arrival for the collection of the passengers, the driver will phone to let you know that he has arrived rather than calling at the door. It is the responsibility of the hirer to ensure that the passengers for travelling are made aware, as the driver cannot physically chase them up.
- Those passengers sat in the back of the wedding car must be, if they can be from the same exclusive '**Support Bubble**' so in turn they do not have to be socially distance from one another. If not it is advised to wear a face covering, as social distancing isn't possible in the back of the car.
- Hand Hygiene - The spread of corona virus is in our hands, meaning everybody can make a difference in preventing transmission through proper hand hygiene. A hand wash station will be available to wash your hands on a regular basis for a minimum of 20 seconds. An alcohol-based sanitiser will be available for this. Please use this in the first instance on entry into the car.
- The driver is protected from the passengers (and vice-versa) by a glass partition divide. This will remain closed at all times and not to be opened by any passenger. Please note that repertory droplets through coughing, sneezing and talking are the main factor in the spread of the virus.
- There will be a supply of tissues in the car for passengers to catch coughs and sneezes with a bin with a closed lid to immediately allow for quick disposal.
- The driver has been instructed to avoid handling passenger's bags and other items if this is possible to do, this may sometimes be not possible if the passengers are incapacitated or elderly.
- If the driver observes a passenger to be unwell and he feels uncomfortable with this, he may at his discretion refuse entry into the car.
- No passengers will be allowed to sit in the front seat.
- The driver will regularly disinfect the car by wiping down door handles, seat belts and paying close attention to surfaces that are touched often with antiseptic wipes.
