Safety Policy

My priority is to ensure the Bridesmaids and Bride's Escort and Bride arrive at the church or place of ceremony on time, and to ensure Bride and Bridegroom arrive at the reception in good time. However, whilst travelling with 'Fabulous Cars' your personal safety is my first concern. I would wish to ensure all passengers arrive safely and comfortably at the destinations and to that end I have developed the following policy for travel in my motorcars:

Closing Doors, Opening Windows and Car Exhaust:

All members of the wedding party will be excited by the day's events so all should take care to avoid fingers being caught in closing doors and if the car windows require opening, please inform the driver due to the nature of the window design. Also when standing close to the rear of the car, please take care of the hot exhaust pipe. Parents or custodians of young bridesmaids are asked to take particular care of 'small fingers' near doors and 'little legs' when walking around the rear of the car.

Travel Speed and Seat Belts (Children travelling in the car)

I will always abide by the road speed limits but in general will normally travel at an appropriate speed to and from locations, thus ensuring the appropriate dignity of the occasion. I will make the journey as comfortable as possible and in accordance with the law I would ask that all passengers wear seat belts (where fitted) at all times while the car is moving. We cannot carry children under 3 years old in any of our classic cars. We ask that you tell us the exact age of children at the time of the car booking that may be travelling in any of our cars. We also ask that you tell the parents of any children above three that they are happy for their children to travel in our vehicles, but must supply their own child seats. The new regulations come into place on March 1st 2017 making it against the law to have the child seats fitted incorrectly. Children over 12 or more than 135cm tall must wear a seat belt. You can choose a child car seat based on your child's height or weight.

No Smoking

In accordance with the law, passengers are respectfully requested not to smoke (inc. E-Cigs) whilst in the car. This will help to ensure a comfortable and safe journey for all and a fresh car for future couples.

Accessories

A celebratory drink service is available by the driver if required (non alcoholic) for the Bride and Groom after the ceremony on the way to the reception. The Bride and Groom are reminded that the drink bottle, and champagne flutes used in the car are all made of glass. Whilst the drink bottle is relatively substantial, the champagne flutes are quite naturally a little fragile. The Bride and Groom are therefore requested to take particular care with their flutes whilst the car is moving so as not to cause them selves harm or cause damage to their special clothing through spillage. Napkins are available for protecting clothing if necessary. The flowers in our motorcars are made of silk and very light and are secure safety in the car.

First Aid Box and Fire Extinguisher

Should this equipment be required it is carried in the under seat storage area of the car.
