COURSE R10/22A (Revised)

R10 22A (Revised) START on Vale of Neath Supplier Estate service road opposite Lamp Post no.18. Proceed eastwards along service road to Resolven Roundabout (0.458miles). NB Safety Notice - Do not cross the centre line of road on right hand bend). Take 1st left along A4565 dual carriageway westbound to 1st exit left (4.862miles). Continue up the loop to Tonna roundabout where take first exit to Aberdulais Interchange. Take 4th exit (5.505miles) down slip road to rejoin A465 dual carriageway. Proceed eastbound to Resolven Roundabout where take 1st exit left to FINISH at access road to Canal Car Park on cross valley link road (10.006miles)

PLEASE NOTE - IT IS THE RIDERS RESPONSIBILITY TO KNOW THE COURSE AND ON THE INSTRUCTION OF SWTRA NO MARSHALLS OR DIRECTION ARROWS WILL BE LOCATED ON THE DUAL CARRIAGEWAY.

DO call your number to the finishing timekeeper or your time may not be recorded.

DO keep your head up, be aware of your surroundings and **HAVE A SAFE RIDE**

Please ensure that you sign on, collect your number and that you return your number, which can be exchanged for a drink

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and Bynea CC are strongly you to wear a hard sheel helmet which meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with rule 15, all junior competitors must wear such a helmet. It is also recommended that a flashing or constant rear light is fitted to your bicycle and is active whilst the cycle is in use.
