COURSE DESCRIPTION RS30/2 (Revised) (FOR SAFETY REASONS the course has been extended by approximately 5 miles to a new START point)

START on unclassified road signposted 'Clytha' (old A40 Raglan to Abergavenny road) at yellow mark on drain cover by Light Standard on flare at western side of entrance to Monmouthshire Livestock Market. (OS 161 384087)	
Continue westbound along unclassified road to descend Clytha Cutting (CARE) to pass junction on right to Llanarth (HQ). Continue along unclassified road to go straight on (to join B4598 at Steel Horse Cafe). Continue along B4598 via Penpergwmm to pass Hardwick Inn on right and pass FINISH point, to start 1st lap.	

Continue westbound to Hardwick roundabout (CARE) and take 1st exit to enter A40 dual carriageway.	6.2
Continue eastbound for 7.5 miles on A40 dual carriageway to Raglan roundabout. Take first left (tight bend) (WITH CARE)	13.7
Follow unclassified road (old A40) to pass Start	15.5
Continue westbound along unclassified road to descend Clytha Cutting (CARE) to pass junction on right to Llanarth (HQ). DIRECTIONS TO HEADQUARTERS

From the South and East - M4 take exit Junction 24

Follow A449 to 2nd exit (Raglan) continue on Dual Carriageway to Raglan Roundabout.

Take 4th exit (Clytha) (unclassified road) Turn right to Llanarth in 3 miles.

From Midlands and North exit M5 junction 8 (Strensham Services) - M50

Follow M50 and A40 via Monmouth (Tunnels) take 1st exit to Abergavenny (remaining on A40) to Raglan Roundabout,

Take 4th exit (Clytha) (unclassified road) Turn right to Llanarth in 3 miles.

From West A465 Heads of the Valleys Road or A40 Brecon

Continue to Abergavenny Hardwick Roundabout; take exit on B4598 signposted Usk. In approx 4 miles keep straight on at Steel Horse Café (DO NOT TURN RIGHT TO USK) continue 0.75 miles to turn left to Llanarth

WARMING UP

Do not warm up on the course in the direction of the race. DO NOT WARM UP PAST THE FINISH TIMEKEEPERS OR YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED

PARKING

Parking is available at the Headquarters. Competitors please do not park in the Officials area.

RIDING TO THE START

Turn left outside HQ; continue approx 1 mile (crossing over A40) to T junction. Turn LEFT and continue for 3 miles towards Raglan. The start is in the entrance area of the new Monmouthshire Livestock Market.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

You should at all times ride at a speed that is within the boundaries of your own bike handling skills, and obey the Highway Code. The Circuit is part Dual Carriageway (clearway). There are 7 laybys in 7.5 miles. The remaining part is undulating, narrow in parts with some sharp bends and double white lines.

Riders need to be attentive at all times, and read the notes on display at the Signing On area in the HQ on the day.

RIDING BACK FROM FINISH

Take care after you finish. Please be aware that the race is 2.25 laps, other teams may still be racing. In the interests of safety early finishers should continue to Hardwick roundabout and circle the entire complex to take the 6th exit B4598 signposted Usk.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO RIDERS AND SUPPORTERS

This event is under 100km “Regulation 22 (a) (use of motor vehicles) does not allow competitors to be preceded, accompanied, followed or in any way receive assistance from occupants of a motor vehicle.

Championship Condition 2 (j)

Numbers – Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16.

Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arm facing forwards

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard
In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Helmets

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use
