A few words about our prize winners on the night. From Severn Road Club, David Leighton took the “best improver” award as he lowered his personal best by 32 seconds. David told us that his previous best was set on the U7B course, which is familiar to a few of us. It's certainly not the quickest, so we might see him visiting our dual carriageways more often in future.

We had eleven veterans among the finishers, all of them substantially ahead of the age-based standard. This was a tightly contested award, but ultimately the prize went to Chris Massey (CES Sport) who beat the standard by an amazing 5m 46s.

Our overall winner on the night was Christopher Gibbard (Bynea Cycling Club) whose average speed exceeded 30mph as he finished with a time of 19m 56s. Superb.

Special mention also goes to Lee Perrott (Cycle Specific) whose new PB made him a contender in all three categories.

As a club we were formed in 2017 and we're still trying to give away our novelty prize of £20.17 to the first rider to clock a time of 20:17. The cheque has been written, we just need someone to claim it! Closest tonight was Philip Tucker, 2nd overall in the event and nine seconds shy of the magic result.

Thanks also to our timekeepers Alf Williams and Robin Field. Thanks again to the VCC members and their families who gave up their free time to provide a safe and welcoming event for everyone.
