If you would like to submit greetings cards, printed or handmade, do make sure that your **name is on the back**, that they are **individually priced in increments of 50p** and **put into cellophane sleeves** for protection.

If you wish to participate, and I hope that you will, it would be appreciated if you could follow the attached instructions, fill in the form carefully and return it together with your **entry fee** as appropriate, as soon as possible but no later than **Monday 3rd July**. Those wishing to submit 3D work can do so by going on-line and sending at least two views of each piece of work to colchesterartsociety.mail@googlemail.com. Alternatively, 3D artists can submit photographs of their work with the submission form. 3D artists will be notified by Monday 10 July 2017 as to whether their work has been accepted.

Good luck and I look forward to seeing you and your guests at the Private View on Saturday, 15th July between 12noon and 2pm.
