Injury from dancing	muscle/back injury	Participants	Low/medium	Warm up and stretch at the beginning and end and age suitable moves to be used only. Ensure everyone is spaced out and have room to move.	BM Teacher
Over-heating from dancing	Fainting / passing out	Participants	Low/medium	Ensure appropriate breaks are given. Dance sessions to be devised according to age. Water to be available at all times during dancing. Teacher to check if anyone has any injuries / pregnant women are going to be dancing prior to the session.	BM Teacher Organiser to provide water.
Choking on food	Choking	Participants	Low/medium	Ensure no food is consumed whilst dancing	BM Teacher
Slipping/ tripping	muscle/injury	participants/spectators teacher	Low/medium	Ensure any food/beverage areas are kept away from the dance area. Spills to be cleared immediately. Teaching area needs to be well lit. Ensure any materials / equipment / bags / trip hazards are kept to the side. Ensure any slippery shoes and socks are removed and participants are wearing trainers or dancing bare feet. Clothing must be suitable for dancing.	Organiser BM Teacher
Sensitivity to face paints / henna / glitter tattoos	Skin allergy	Participants (at parties/ events)	Low/medium	Suitable products for age groups to be used only. Check with parents that children do not have allergies.	BM Teacher Organiser / Host
