

# Daily Care of a Horse

Looking after horses takes time and dedication. They need to be checked at least once a day and more often if they are stabled or the weather is bad. These are some of the daily tasks you need to do.



Check the horse has fresh clean water either in a bucket or in a water trough.



Check the horse has access to a source of food which can be grass in a field or hay (dried grass).



Pick out the horse's feet to check the feet are in good condition, to remove any stones that may be lodged and check the shoes are in place.



Groom the horse and check over the horse for any signs of injury. Look for cuts or swellings especially on the horse's legs.
