

What horses eat



Horses love to eat grass. It is the food they would eat in the wild but sometimes it can get too rich especially in the spring.

Hay is dried grass and it is fed to horses in the winter when there isn't enough grass in the field or when the horse is in a stable overnight.



Horses need to drink water to survive. It drinks 30 - 50 litres a day so you need a big bucket!

Horses can also be fed different types of feeds. Some feed looks like muesli and is called mix. Other feeds look pellets and these are called pony nuts. Horses enjoy carrots too.
