Competition Information

Rider Registration and Numbers

Upon RDA groups arriving at the Countryside Challenge Qualifier, the group leader will be responsible for reporting to the event secretary located in the Scropton Coffee Bar. Here they will be able to collect numbers for each of their riders. Individual riders are not required to visit the event secretary and instead must report to their RDA group leader or instructors.

Rider Times

All rider times can be found on the following pages of this booklet as well as having been sent to each RDA group leader. Riders and horses must be warmed up and ready to leave the warm up arena 5 minutes before their test time for the tack check and to ensure the competition runs to time.

Course Walks

Riders will only be allowed to walk the course in the main arena during allocated course walk times found on the competition schedule. Horses will not be allowed in the main arena except for their allocated class times. To recap, course walk times are:

Horsehire

Loan horses and ponies from Scropton RDA have been allocated to all who have requested them. Loan horses will aim to be made available 30 minutes before the riders time and will be tacked up ready including a full bridle with couplings to the bit for leading. All horses will come with a white numnah however if you wish to use your own, please let us know in advance. Seperate information including horse profiles will be sent out to individual groups

Horse Care Challenge

Throughout the day there will be the chance for all RDA participants to test their horse care knowledge whilst they're at the Countryside Challenge Competition. The questions will be based on the RDA Proficiency tests and everyone will get a rosette for taking part. There will be no charge for riders wishing to take part in this.

Scropton Riding and Driving Centre is home to Scropton Riding for the Disabled, one of a small number of purpose built RDA centres. We are open 7 days a week and offer both riding and driving lessons to over 200 disabled people of varying ages and disabilities, as well as offering lessons to local abled bodied riders. 2015 is an exciting year for us as it will be our 50th anniversary operating as an RDA group, having signed our registration papers all the way back in 1965!
