All cups and trophies are held for ONE year and a £20 deposit is required.

This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 12th - 16th August 2015.

The two highest exhibits not already qualified in classes 15-18 and 21-24 will qualify.

Main Ring: 8.30 a.m.

Horse & Pony Open Jumping

Incorporating BS Club Jumping (open to unaffiliated riders and BS Club members)

Classes start at 8.30am

Entry fee: £6.00 · **1st** £10 · **2nd** £8 · **3rd** £6 **Rosettes:** to 6th place
 These classes will be run under British Show Jumping rules.

For any horse/rider, pony/rider combination without a registered result in National Amateur 90cm., British Novice, Pony British Novice, Stepping Stones and above in the last 3 years.

Competitors can register as Club Members up to 7 days after the competition and regain points won.

Horses and ponies will be split if there are more than 15 starters. Children can ride horses from the beginning of the calendar year in which they are 12.

Class 1: THE BLASTON NOVICE CUP

80 cm Horse and Pony Open Jumping Incorporating BS Club Jumping. Height 80cm. Time limit of 2 minutes allowed in the first section of the course. Table/Speed single Phase 325mpm. Regional points will be awarded in Riders own league.

Class 2: THE BLASTON SHOW ACCUMULATOR CUP

90cm Horse and Pony Open Jumping Incorporating BS Club Jumping. Height 90cm. Time limit of 2 minutes allowed in the first section of the course. Table/Speed Single phase 325mpm. Regional points will be awarded in Riders own league.

Class 3: THE BLASTON SHOW GRAND PRIX CUP

1.00m Horse and Pony Open Jumping incorporating BS Club Jumping. Height 1.00m. Time limit of 2 minutes allowed in the first section of the course. Table/Speed single phase/325mpm. Regional points will be awarded in Riders own league.

Skull Caps to standard PAS105 or BN1384 must be worn
 The judge's decision is final BUT objections can be lodged with a £20 deposit to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the Class closing.
 Points will be awarded to those competitors who are BS Club members in line with BS Rules and Regulations.

Fancy Dress

Entry fee: £2.50 **Rosettes and prizes for all competitors**

This class is open to everyone with or without a pony.

Mounted competitors must wear a hard hat.

There will display of all entrants in this class at Welland Valley Feeds on the week following the show.

Ring 1: 9.00 a.m.

Horse and Pony Classes

Entry fee: £6.00 · **Rosettes:** to 6th place

Class 4: IN HAND YOUNG STOCK

The winner to receive The Overstone Perpetual Challenge Cup.

Open to Horses and ponies one, two and three years old. To be judged on conformation and turnout.

Class 5: BEST TURNED OUT

The winner to receive the Blaston Show Plaque.

Open to horses and ponies of any height and riders of any age and judged 100% on turnout.

Class 6: LEAD REIN

The winner to receive the Perpetual Challenge Bowl.

Open to riders 10 years and under and ponies 127 centimetres (12.2 hh) and under, to be ridden in a snaffle bit with lead rein on noseband and judged on suitability of pony.

Class 7: FIRST RIDDEN (not on a lead rein)

The winner to receive the R. T. Challenge Cup.

Open to riders 12 years and under and ponies 137 centimetres (13.2 hh) and under, ridden in snaffle bridle and judged on suitability of pony. Cantering optional.

Ring 1: Continued

Horse and Pony Classes

Class 8: HUNTER TYPE PONY

The winner to receive the Noverly Kirnel Perpetual Challenge Shield.

Open to riders of any age and to ponies 148 cm. (14.2 hh) and under. Judged on a combination of performance, manners and type.

Class 9: FAMILY HORSE OR PONY

The winner to receive the Fernie Pony Club Cup.

Open to riders of any age and to horses and ponies. Judged on a combination of turnout, performance (must jump a very small jump) and suitability as an absolute all rounder.

Classes 10-14 will not start before 12.30 p.m.

Class 10: RIDDEN EX-RACEHORSE

The winner to receive the 'John' Trophy.

Open to all thoroughbreds unraced and raced 4 years and over that have been "in training" and are registered with Wetherbys. Class to be judged on turnout, manners, way of going, performance and conformation.

Class 11: IN HAND VETERAN

The winner to receive the Storm Challenge Shield.

Open to horses and ponies of any height over 15 years of age.

Class 12: MATURE RIDERS CLASS

The winner to receive The Jay Dawson Challenge Cup.

Open to riders 45 years of age and over and to horse and ponies. To be judged on turnout and individual show only.

Class 13: RIDDEN COLOURED

The winner to receive the Henry Tate Challenge Cup.

Open to riders of any age and to skewbald and piebald horses and ponies of any height.

Class 14: RIDDEN VETERAN

The winner to receive the Falcon Hotel Challenge Cup.

Open to riders of any age and to horses and ponies over 15 years of age of any height.

Ring 2: 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon

Minimus Jumping

Entry fee: £2.50 to be paid at ringside

Open to riders of any age and to horses and ponies. This course will be very small with the aim of encouraging riders to get round happily. All competitors jumping a clear round will receive a rosette. No limit to the number of times competitors may enter.

Ring 2: 12.30 - 2.30 p.m.

RDA Handy Pony/Horse

Entry fee: £2.50 to be paid at ringside

12.30 - 1.30p.m. - This class is ONLY open to members of a current RDA Group. **1.30p.m. onwards** - The class is open to non RDA members.

Open to riders of any age. All competitors with clear rounds will receive a rosette. No limit to the number of times competitors may enter.

Ring 2: 2.30 p.m. onwards

Gymkhana Events

Entry fee: £2.50 per class or four classes for £8.00 to be paid at the ringside. **Rosettes:** to 6th place

Three age groups – Lead rein, Under 8 years and Under 12 years.

Please note qualification cards for classes 15-18 and 21-24 must be downloaded from Equifest prior to the show in order for judges to sign on the day.

Entry fee: £6.00 **Rosettes:** to 6th place

Class 15: Miss Jo Brew/EQUIFEST OPEN SMALL HUNTERS

The Winner to receive the Copper Man Plate.

Open Small Hunter mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms (14.2hh) but not exceeding 158cms (15.2hh). Riders any age.

Class 16: Mr E & Mrs S.A. Kydd/EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS

The winner to receive the Blaston Show Challenge Cup.

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153 cms. (15.0 hh). Rider any age.

Class 17: Nupafeed/EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS

The winner to receive the Members Trophy

Open ridden cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148 cms. (14.2 hh), but not exceeding 155 cms. (15.1 hh) Riders any age.

Class 18: Nupafeed/EQUIFEST RIDING HORSES

The winner to receive the Ernest Harrison Challenge Cup.

Open riding horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Rider any age.

Class 19: Working Hunter Pony/NOT EQUIFEST AFFILIATED

Sponsored by the Wheel and Compass Pub, Weston by Welland.

For ponies 148 cms (14.2 hh) and under. Fences will not exceed 76 cms (2ft 6 inches)

The winner to receive the Fernie Feeds Working Hunter Pony Cup.

The highest placed pony that has been hunted in the Fernie or Cottesmore countries in the last season will receive the Huntsman Trophy.

Class 20: Working Hunter/NOT EQUIFEST AFFILIATED

Sponsored by Town and Country Veterinary Centre, Market Harborough.

For horses over 148 cms (14.2hh). Fences will not exceed 83cms (2ft 9 inches).

The winner to receive the Blaston Show Working Hunter Champion Plate.

The highest placed horse that has been hunted in the Fernie or Cottesmore countries in the last season will receive the Huntsman Trophy.

Ring 3: 2.30 p.m.

Classes 21-24 will not start before 2.30 p.m.

Entry fee: £6.00 **Rosettes:** to 6th place

Class 21: Drumacre Hall Stud/EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND IN HAND - SMALL BREEDS

The winner to receive the Nab a Koo Trophy.

Open to in hand mountain and moorland ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B. stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

Class 22: Drumacre Hall Stud/EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND IN HAND - LARGE BREEDS

The winner to receive the Balleroy Cragman Trophy.

Open to in hand mountain and moorland ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. stallion, mare, colt filly or gelding, any age.

Class 23: The Hewitt Family/EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS

The winner to receive the Blaston Show Mountain and Moorland Cup.

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies, registered with their respective pure bread societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding 4 years old and over, riders any age.

Class 24: Equimax/EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS

The winner to receive the Gamesmaster Trophy.

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective pure bread societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over. Rider any age.
