## Welcome

Hello and welcome to the North Midlands Regional Fun Day 2018. We hope you enjoy the chance to have a go at competing at a regional level.

## Competition Information

### Group Registration and Passports

Upon arrival RDA group leaders are responsible for reporting to the event secretary who will be located in the Coffee Bar. Passports of all horses must be presented for checking before they are unloaded.

### Rider Hat Tagging and Numbers

Individual riders are required to see the secretary to have their hat checked that it meets current safety standards and to have it tagged with a green RDA competition tag. Riders will be given their numbers once their hat has been tagged.

### Rider Times

Rider times are included in this information. Riders and horses **must** be warmed up and ready to leave the warm up arena **5 minutes** before their competing time to allow for the tack check and to ensure the competition runs to time.

### Arenas

Warming up will be in the indoor arena and the competitions will take place in the outdoor arena

### Course Walks

Rider Course walk for the Countryside Challenge : 9.30 - 10.00am  
Horse Arena walk : 9.00 - 9.30 am

### Rosette Presentation

Clear Round Rosettes for the Countryside Challenge will be presented to each rider on completing the course.

The presentation for the Dressage Classes will take place at the end of the event.



## Horse Hire

Loan horses and ponies from Scropton RDA have been allocated to all riders who have requested them. Loan horses will aim to be made available 30 minutes before rider's times subject to availability as some horses are being used by more than one RDA group. Horses will be tacked up ready including a full bridle with coupling to the bit for leading. All horses will have a white saddle cloth, however if you wish to use your own please let us know in advance.

## Venue Background

Scropton Riding & Driving Centre is home to Scropton Riding for the Disabled, one of a small number of purpose built RDA centres. We are open 6 days a week and offer both riding and driving lessons to over 300 disabled people of varying ages and disabilities, as well as offering lessons to local abled bodied riders.

## Catering

We have a lovely coffee bar which will be open throughout the competition day with plenty of indoor seating as well as outdoors for those sunny days. Free tea, coffee and squash will be available to all riders and supporters. We will also have a range of cobs, cakes, snacks, soft drinks and other such delights available to buy.
