Competition Start **10.00am**. All Anglers must be ready to leave shore by **9.30.am**

Competition Finish **5.00pm Sharp** All Boats must be inside the two orange buoys by **5.15pm**

Score Cards will be handed out to registered competitors and you will each be responsible for its completion & it's return after the competition to the Adjudicators.

Score Cards must be handed into the Adjudicators immediately on your return to shore, **before** you return to your vehicle, regardless of if you have a catch or not.

Entry Fee €75 [euros] per Competitor.

Closing date of Entry **Before Midnight Wednesday 29th June 2022**

Entry Fee must be lodged by this date.

Results will begin at 6:00 pm.

Due to Covid 19: Under WHO guidelines, we are still classified as under Pandemic.

Score Cards: you are responsible for the completion of your own scorecard, and it's return after the competition to the Adjudicators.

HEALTH & SAFETY: Life jackets are compulsory [of approved standard]. Glasses and a Hat for eye and hair protection are compulsory Failure to wear any designated item will result in refusal to access boat. . Also, advice is to use a high factor sun block and keep arms covered. Drogues may be used if so wished.

Please ensure you register your Name & Trial on lodgement slip when paying in your entry Fee.

1. The Date of your Lodgement of your Competition Fee of €75 Euros will be registered as the Date of your Payment of your Competition Entry on the Bank of Ireland Statement and/ the Irish Ladies PayPal Account, whichever you use.
