Please note when looking at the relevant pitch size, bear in mind a caravan tow bar must not overhang your pitch. While some motorhomes have racking on the back, which again, cannot overhang the pitch. If you are planning to bring an extra car, ensure that you have chosen the correct pitch size and type.





ELECTRIC HOOK UP

If you have booked to include Electric Hook Up we will provide one 6amp single phase CeeForm socket on a distribution board in in an area on / near the Campers Pitch if booked with Electric Hook Up. Each Camper who has booked an Electric Hook Up pitch must provide a suitable cable to facilitate their hook up from the pitch-side distribution board as follows:

- For an Electric Hook Up Tent Pitch, this cable should be a 16a single phase CeeForm plug (blue) with an appropriate grade of double insulated, three core outdoor cable, 1.5mm or larger) twin and earth is not acceptable). The other end of the cable should be a 13a socket with some form of protection, electrical and mechanical. Ideally the cable should be 25m in length.

Microwave Cooker	1200W	5.2 amps
Colour TV	50W	0.2 amps
Battery Charger	100W	0.4 amps
Refrigerator	125W	0.5 amps
Table Lamp	60W	0.2 amps
Blown Air Heater	Due to the high wattage for these systems it is recommended, where possible, they are limited to 500w

- Charcoal or disposable BBQs of any kind
- Generators
- Monkeybikes, Minimoto, Pit Bikes, Powered Scooters, Segways & Quads
- BBQ Gas cylinders exceeding 15kg
- Sound systems capable of creating excessive noise
- Campfires, firewood & fire starters
- Fireworks, pyrotechnics, smoke cannisters & Chinese Lanterns are not permitted.
- Restricted & illegal substances
- Offensive weapons
- Paddling pools, swimming pools & hot tubs
- Pet animals



Camping Safety Rules

We have taken precautions and will have staff patrolling the site, but they cannot be watching all areas at once, and we therefore ask that you do not leave your valuable lying around. We recommend that you lock anything of value away at all times, or keep them on you.

Ensure your campervan, caravan, motorhome is locked, and suggest a lock for tents where possible



FIRE

There are fire points with water buckets (not for gas or electrical fires) & rotary alarms around the site.

Powder fire extinguishers can be found at the Driving Range; these can be used on any type of fire but must only be used in the event of an emergency.

CARBON MONOXIDE POISONING

Carbon monoxide (CO) is produced when a fuel such as charcoal, gas or petrol burns incompletely. This could be because an appliance isn't working properly or might simply happen as part of its normal function.

Barbecues, for example, produce carbon monoxide even when they are working well. Please do not operate your gas barbecue inside or at the entrance of your tents.

MEDICAL ISSUES
