



THE FA Emergency Action Plan

- Each team must have an identified FA FIRST AIDER prior to any game or training session.

- You must have a mobile phone with you
- In an emergency dial 999 or 112 (gives GPS to emergency services)

Emergency Action Policy

- The Team Manager shall:
- Ensure you know that the first aider has a FA FIRST AIDER qualification that is in date
- Ensure your first aid kit is with you and in date
- Ensure your mobile phone is available and charged
- Ensure you know the post code for the pitch you are playing at
- Ensure that you check your own player cards each game for player medical conditions and that it has an emergency contact number
- Ensure you have all player MEDICAL EQUIPMENT in a safe place for medical conditions
- Ensure the match day environment is safe and appropriate for football
- Have a colleague who can support you should an incident occur
- Ensure that you check your own player cards each game for player medical conditions and that it has an emergency contact number
- Act in line with the FA First Aid Qualification should you need to
- NO FIRST AIDER – NO MATCH NO MEDICAL EQUIPMENT – CAN'T PLAY
