

From the Chair...

Happy New Year to you all! I hope you had a good Christmas.

The new term begins on Thursday, 8th January 2015 with our rehearsal at the usual time of 8.00 to 10.00 pm in St Cedd's School Hall.

It seems a while ago now that we were singing Bliss and Duruflé in the Cathedral. It was a shame that we did not have a larger audience, but that didn't take away from my enjoyment of what I thought was a good concert. It was lovely to sing the Bliss with the extra colour that the strings and flute add to the texture and amazing to hear the quality and depth of tone that Kate Symonds-Joy produced in her solos in both works. Our first time with St Paul's Sinfonia seemed a success and it is good to know another orchestra that we can work with in future.

There will be no less musical excitement this term with the music of Zelenka, Biber and Vivaldi culminating in our concert on Saturday, 14th March accompanied by the excellent Meridien Sinfonia. I have become increasingly fond of the early music repertoire over the past few years: the energy and stature of some of these works is still remarkable today and must have been so much more spectacular in their own time. Vivaldi needs no introduction. But if recommendation were needed for Zelenka, he was admired by JS Bach who hosted him as a guest in his own home and even had some of his works copied for use at Leipzig. Biber was one of the greatest violinist of his time, developing new techniques for the instrument, and composed much of his music for the Salzburg Court, where the Requiem would first have been performed in the Cathedral. As announced at the end of last term, we are hoping that many, if not all, of the solos in March's concert will be taken by members of the choir and I hope some of you have been practising over the break in preparation for trying things through when we return.

Earlier in the term, on Saturday, 31st January, we have our Quiz Night in the Hulton Hall at Great Waltham starting at 7.30 pm (doors open at 7.00 pm). We are grateful to Mike Wall for making the arrangements once again and for returning to the chair as our quizmaster that evening. If you haven't been to a Waltham Singers quiz night before, please do come along, either forming your own team (of 8) or letting Mike Wall know you are looking for a team to join. It's great fun and all very relaxed.

On the administrative front, we are still looking for someone to take on the responsibilities of organising the bar for our various social events. If you are able to help with this or would like to help in the running of the choir any other way, then please let me or any of the other committee members know.

Enjoy the remainder of the break and I look forward to seeing you all on Thursday, 8th January.
