

Method for lining sleeveless dresses with a facing or lining (also for lining a grown-on-strap bag)

1. Sew facing and outer exterior of fabric sides together armholes and neck, stopping 3.5cm from the shoulders (see 1st pic)
2. Snip curved seams then turn through and press, pulling out the fabric fully on the seams
3. Sew the facing shoulders together with and the outer shoulders together (exterior sides together)
4. Pull inside out again and sew the sides of the shoulder straps taking care to push everything inside to one side so you don't catch it
5. Turn through to outside again and press! Finish rest of bag/dress
