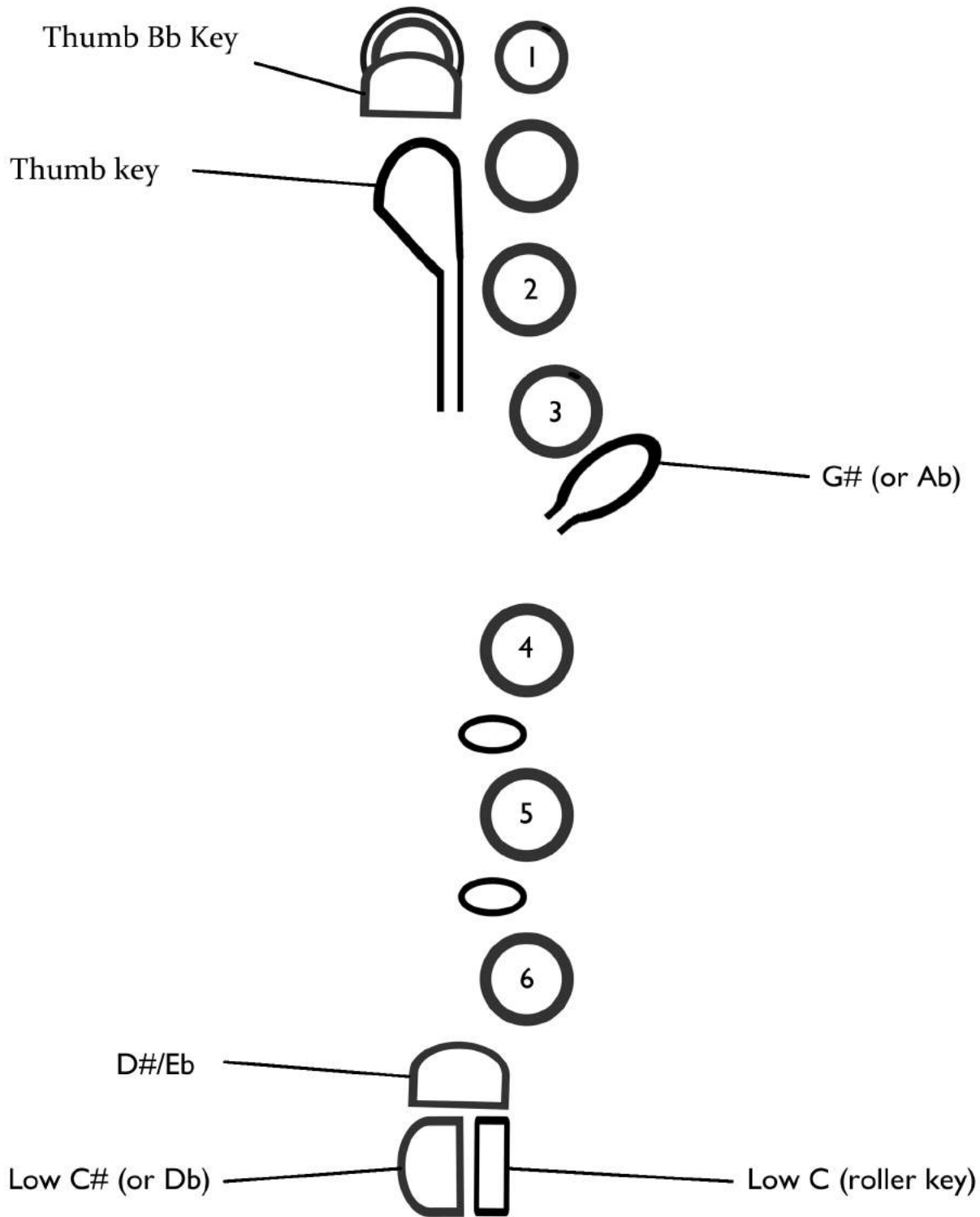



# Flute Key Guide





Musical staff showing notes: C, C# (or Db), D, D# (or Eb)






Musical staff showing notes: E, F, F# (or Gb), G








Musical staff showing notes: G# (or Ab), A, Bb (or A#), B


