The Cemetery

Aldershot Military Cemetery contains the graves of men and women of many nations, many of whom served and died in Aldershot over the last one hundred and twenty years. Wives and children of all ranks and some civilian who have spent their lives with the forces are entitled to be buried here.



The Chapel

The red brick chapel, built in 1879, stands just inside the entrance gates, which is the highest point of the cemetery and replaces the wooden chapel sited further down the hill, which had been burnt down some time earlier.

The Remembrance Book

The babies and children's remembrance book is available for anyone who has a child buried at the cemetery or has a family connection with the British Armed Services.

The remembrance book is a permanent dedication to all the precious babies and children who have died, wherever or however long ago. The remembrance book is for babies and children, whether the cause of death was stillbirth, neonatal death, cot death, illness or accident etc.



Entering Your Child's Name

Entry of a name in to the remembrance book is free. However if you feel you would like to make a donation towards the costs of the remembrance book, please send any donations to the address on this pamphlet.
