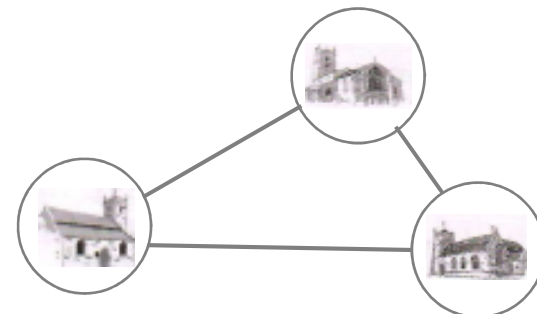

The Collect for today:
