| 0-5 mins | Proclaim God's Glory. Give Him thanks and praise for the wonderful things He does/is: The source of all steadfastness and encouragement; compassionate and merciful God; El-Shaddai (All-sufficient One); Jehovah-Jireh (God the Provider); Jehovah-Ropheka (Lord who heals); Jehovah-Shalom (the Lord is Peace); Lord of the whole world; Jesus Christ the Way, the Truth and the Life; The Lamb who was slain; The Lamb upon the Throne; Christ the Hope of Glory; Holy Spirit the Counsellor; Paraclete (One who comes alongside); Spirit of Glory; Spirit of Liberty; Love; Truth; Holiness; Self-control. |
| 6-10 mins | Seeking God's glory through holiness: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is there unconfessed sin in my life? • Do I have unforgiveness and bitterness in my life? • Are there any doubtful practices in my life? • Do I always obey the Holy Spirit promptly? • Do I confess Jesus unashamedly? |
| 11-15 mins | Seeking God's glory through salvation of the lost Pray for five individuals who do not yet follow Jesus as their Lord and Saviour: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. Pray for their salvation, that God will bless them spiritually, socially and emotionally. |
| 16-20 mins | Seeking God's glory in the church. Pray for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Congregations to be restored as houses of prayer for all nations (Is 56:7, Mt 21:13) • Congregations to fulfil the Great Commission (Mt 28:18-20) • Congregations to fulfil the Great Commandment (Mt 22:37-40) • For spiritual revival in the church • For a church that will be faithful to the Word and relevant to addressing the needs of people. |
| 21-25 mins | Seeking God's glory by asking for "our daily bread" and praying for your personal needs: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. |
| 26-30 mins | Seeking God's glory by watching and listening to Him: Ask the Lord to reveal new things to you, things that He wants you to notice and pay attention to. Ask Him to reveal His will and plans for you. Ask Him for things that are on His heart that He wants you to pray about. (Write down what you sense He is saying to you) |

| 31-35 mins | <p>Seeking God's glory in the nations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pray for all nations to see that Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life (Jn 14:6) • Pray that all unreached people on earth will be reached with the gospel • Pray for the coming of God's peace and glory to all countries and nations • Pray that rulers and governments will submit to the Lordship of Jesus • Pray that God will bless the nations |
| 36-40 mins | <p>Seeking God's glory in the breaking of strongholds of evil and for people to repent of their involvement in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immorality • Racism • Injustice • Witchcraft and idolatry • Ungodly covenants |
| 41-45 mins | <p>Seeking God's glory through His intervention and breakthroughs in the following global challenges. Pray about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The COVID-19 pandemic • The increasing number of poor and needy people • Corruption on all levels • The persecuted church in many nations • Wars, violence and the refugees displaced from their homelands |
| 46-50 mins | <p>Seeking God's glory through the youth of today, Pray:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • That this generation of young people will reach their generation with the gospel • For young people to come to a new intimacy with God and obedience to Him • For radical committed disciples living in holiness • For young people to radically serve God and follow Him wherever He leads • For compassionate hearts, to reach the homeless and serve the poor |
| 51-55 mins | <p>Seeking God's glory through forgiveness and reconciliation. Pray:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • That nations will confess their sins of hurting, suppressing and abusing their own people and other nations • For reconciliation on all levels (in families, oppression of ethnic groups, between churches and denominations, between countries) • For the breaking of strongholds, structures and political systems that destroy the lives of people • That individuals, families, ethnic and minority groups will forgive those who have mistreated them on any way • For God to bring about acts of restitution and blessing |
| 56-60 mins | <p>Seeking God's glory through praise and worship: Conclude your time of prayer with praise and worship. Thank God for His goodness and take time to bless individuals who come to mind, in the Name of the Lord Jesus.</p> |
