



C Award Umpire As-

essment

The EN pathway for the C Award is as follows:

Attend An Introduction To Officiating Course - 3 hour Course

Attend a C Award Course - 6 hour. Must progress to the written assessment within 2 years of attending the Course.

Avon Netball C Award Umpire Co- Ordinator is Karen Hill - hill.k7@sky.com . She will contact all attendees and invite them to the next available Written Assessment evening. The cost of the written assessment is £12.50 (this includes MSFT fee)

Written Assessment consists of a 30 minute paper, divided into 2 sections. Section 1 requires yes/no answers - minimum pass level is 17/20

Section 2 requires longer answers, there are 5 questions (10 marks available) - minimum pass level is 7/10

Umpires must pass both sections to pass the Written Assessment. This is valid for 2 years.

To progress to the next stage, the Practical Assessment, Umpires can receive mentoring from experienced Umpires and Mentors in Avon. This is co-ordinated by Sandra Nash - Sandra.nash@bt.com . There is also a Workbook available to help with this progression.

Once an umpire feels they are ready, a Pre Assessment for the practical will be arranged by Sandra.

The cost of the C Award practical is £45.00. This covers cost of Pre Assessment and the actual Practical Assessment. Prior to taking the Practical Assessment, (within 6 weeks) the umpire will need to complete a Multi Stage Fitness Test. The minimum requirement is 4.1. This will increase to 5.1 in January 2016.

The C Award Practical Assessment will be carried out on league game, usually at Div 5/6/7 level. Arranged by Karen Hill.
