

THE CONVOY

- around two weeks before the relay road signs will be erected at main entrances to the town warning motorists of possible delays
- as the torch convoy approaches a rolling road closure of the main route and all side roads will begin causing delays from 11.04 - 11.22am
- the convoy will travel at 4mph - police and stewards will be positioned along the route to offer advice, help and directions
- some current parking areas will be sectioned off for schools and spectators and protected by barriers or cones on June 20.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

Residents are advised to:

- make sure all vehicles are removed from the route in advance of the convoy
- remember that you may not be able to move your car while the convoy passes
- avoid arranging any critical deliveries or appointments at this time.

Businesses, schools, places of worship, service organisations are advised to:

- note the areas that have been designated for schools and spectators and make alternative arrangements for visitors and deliveries if needed - allowing for delays
- notify customers and staff in advance, if possible
- consider if events may be affected - weddings, funerals, medical appointments
- consider allowing staff to come out and watch the relay
- consider decorating premises to animate the route
- note that London Organising Committee of the Olympic Games (LOCOG) will be protecting the use of all names, phrases, marks, logos and designs relating to the 2012 Games.

Drivers are advised to:

- avoid travelling on the route itself - consider making short journeys on foot or using off-road cycle routes. Vehicles travelling on the same route will have limited opportunities to pass the convoy.

Public transport users are advised to:

- expect delays to buses/taxis that use roads on or near the route
- note that the route passes close to railway stations
- allow extra time to catch public transport.
