Wooden Salad Bowl

One of the first large projects I undertook was to make a Salad Bowl. During lockdown I thought I would have another try.



The chosen wood was cedar, so let's try again, whilst making a picture book.



A nice 70mm by 400mm blank of Cedar.(2.75in by 15.75in)



Screwing on an Axminster face plate ring.



Ready to go





First a little sharpening using his Sorby Pro-edge.



As usual, outside first with a re-chucking point. I use a parting tool and a small skew to undercut it. My main bowl gouge is a 12.7mm Crown Cryo beast (approx 1/2in). With a smaller Axminster 9.5mm gouge (3/8th in).

Finally, any different? No, a salad bowl is a salad bowl, but much better wood turning. Anyway, it will be back on the lathe as I was not happy with the shape.

Only took a fraction of the time of the first one with minimal sanding, so I must have improved over the years.
