



Linked Up Necklace



What You Will Need

- 30 x 10mm Czech fire-polished beads
- 0.8mm jewellery wire
- 1 x 4mm jump ring
- 1 x lobster clasp
- 1 x headpin

In addition you will require wire cutters, a pair of flat nosed pliers and a pair of round nose pliers.

1. Trim your jewellery wire into 3 inch lengths – you will need approximately 30 of these depending on how long you would like to make your necklace.
2. Picking up a 2inch piece of wire use your pliers to create a wrapped loop at one end and add the jump ring and lobster clasp (Fig 1).
3. Thread on a 10mm fire polished bead and use your pliers to create a wrapped loop at the other end (Fig 2). It is important that you make all of your wrapped loops large enough for the lobster clasp to connect on to.
4. Pick up the next piece of jewellery wire and make a wrapped loop on one end and add another bead. This time start to make the wrapped loop on the other end but as you make the loop link on the last bead before wrapping (Fig 3).
5. Continue on in this way until the necklace is the desired length. To finish off add the last bead on to the headpin. Wrap a loop at the other end of the headpin and add to the necklace (Fig 4).
6. The lobster clasp can now be linked onto any of the wrapped loops allowing the wearer to customise how they wear it. For example it can be worn as one longer necklace, wrapped round the wrist as a bracelet or worn as a choker with a long dropper down the nape of the neck.
