



## Wired Pendant



### What You Will Need

- 0.8mm jewellery wire
- 0.4mm jewellery wire
- 5 x 4mm Swarovski crystals
- Large feature bead
- 3 x 4mm jump ring
- Micro-fibre suede or cord for stringing
- Box ends
- Lobster clasp

1. Cut off a length of 0.8mm wire approximately 15 cm/6 inches. Using your round nose pliers make a swirl effect on one end of the wire (Fig 1).
2. Thread on your feature bead and leaving a gap either side of the bead make a wrapped loop (Fig 2).
3. Take the 0.8mm wire you have left and secure a length of 0.4 as close to the wrapped loop as possible. Wrap the 0.4mm wire around the 0.8mm wire 4 times and add a Swarovski crystal. Wrap another 4 times and add another. Repeat this process until you have wired all 5 crystals onto the length of 0.8mm wire. Secure the end of the 0.4mm wire and trim off the end (Fig 3).
4. Using your fingers manipulate the wrapped 0.8mm wire down one side of the feature bead before looping the wire back round the top of the swirl.
5. Bring the wire back up the centre of the back of the feature bead and wrap again at the top to secure. Trim off any excess wire (Fig 4).
6. Add a jump ring to the loop and finish off by threading a cord through the jump ring using box ends and jump rings to attach a lobster clasp (as per main picture).
