



Wonderfully Wired Necklace



What You Will Need

0.6mm jewellery wire

2 x end caps

2 x jump rings

1 x lobster clasp

Selection of beads – we have used 6mm Czech glass fire polished beads in 3 contrasting colours

In addition you will require cutter pliers, a pair of flat nosed pliers and a pair of round nose pliers.



Top Tip!!!

Add extra sparkle to your design by using Swarovski crystals or why not use up any Bead Soup.

1. Trim 3 lengths of your 0.6mm wire all measuring 1.2m in length. This will give you a choker length necklace. Cut the wire longer for a longer length necklace.
2. Take the first piece of wire and set the other two aside. Leaving a tail of 5cm start making small peaks and trough approx 1cm high using your round nose pliers. Make 3 peaks and add a bead (Fig 1)
3. Make another three peaks and troughs and add another bead. Continue like this all the way to the end of your wire, leaving a tail of 5cm at the other end too (Fig 2). Set aside.
4. Pick up your second piece of wire and leaving a length of 5cm again make two peaks and troughs before adding a different coloured bead (Fig 3).
5. Make another two peaks and troughs and add another bead. Continue like this all the way to the end of your wire, leaving a length of 5cm at the other end too (Fig 4). Set aside.
6. Repeat the same steps with the third piece of wire but this time just make one peak and trough between each bead and use another colour bead (Fig 5).
7. Pick up all three pieces of wire and bring the three ends together. Using two pieces of wire tightly wrap them around the third four times to secure and trim any excess (Fig 6)
8. Thread the remaining end of wire through the bead cap and create a wrapped loop (Fig 7)
9. Once secure start mixing the three wires together scrunching them up gently. Scrunch and gently twist them together (Fig 8) before repeating Steps 7 and 8 with the other end.
10. Add a jump ring to one of the wrapped loops and a jump ring and lobster clasp to the other.
