CLASS Fence Height Description

1 30cms Lead Rein

2 40cms Beginners/First Ridden

Mini Championship for Classes 1 and 2 (open to those gaining "Gold" rosettes first time over course)

3 50cms Working Hunter

4 60cms Working Hunter

5 70cms Working Hunter

Intermediate Championship for Classes 3, 4 and 5 (open to those gaining "Gold" rosettes first time over course)

6 80cms Working Hunter

7 90cms Working Hunter

Open Championship for Classes 6 and 7 (open to those gaining "Gold" rosettes first time over course)

Entry Fees:

Classes 1 & 2 = £5.00

Classes 3 to 7 = £10.00 first entry in a class, subsequent entries in that class £5.00

Entries taken on the Day

Rosettes: Gold, Silver and Bronze rosettes awarded based on individual scores

The course will be FULLY dressed working hunter fences, lots of fillers and variety and up to height. There will be penalties for stops and poles down but in interests of schooling if any horse/rider is eliminated at any one fence, competitor can go on to try another fence. Fall of horse/rider is automatic elimination, both horse and rider must leave arena at a walk

Eligibility -

All classes are open to horses & ponies, irrespective of type or age of rider. All riders should be suitably mounted

Rules and Conditions

All mounted persons must wear a riding hat with harness fastened at all times to a minimum recommended standard of PAS 015(1998 or 2011) with BSI Kitemark, VG1 01.040:2014-12 with BSI Kitemark, ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a) with SEI mark, SNELL E2001 with official SNELL label and number, or AS/NZS 3838(2006) with SAI Global mark
Correct footwear to be worn

No horses or ponies under 4 years old may compete

The Judge's decision is Final

Any objection must be made in writing with 10 minutes of class ending, accompanied by a £15 non-refundable deposit

The organisers reserve the right to amend the schedule without notice

ALL children attending must be supervised by an adult

Only horse/ponies entered in the competition are allowed in the warm up area



Rosettes will be awarded as follows

Gold : Competitors scoring 85% +

Silver : Competitors scoring between 65% - 84.9%

Bronze : Competitors scoring between 40% - 64.9%

Judged/marked as follows

40% jumping, 25% style, 35% manners

No individual show required

Competitors may enter a class more than once but in any one class a competitor can only be awarded ONE bronze, silver and gold rosette
