*Please note that Preliminary entries on the official forms must be at BRC HQ, Stoneleigh by Friday 13th September 2019.

*Only full members who have been declared to BRC HQ by this date are eligible to compete in the qualifying competition.

*Area entries must be on official forms downloaded from www.britishridingclubs.org.uk

*Area closing date is Friday 23rd September 2019.

*Team Managers will be required to declare their team on arrival, and not later than 30 minutes before the start of the class, using the official Declaration Forms supplied by BRC HQ.

*Each horse in the qualifying competition will be checked against the Flu Vaccination Certificate brought with the competitor. Any horse with a certificate found to be incorrect may be allowed to enter H.C. at the discretion of the Official Steward, but this counts as disqualification, so they may not be replaced in their team, either at the qualifier or at the finals, should the team qualify.

*As a rule of entrance, each Area 21 Riding Club who wishes to enter the Dressage must supply the name and contact number of one person willing to assist of the day. The job role will be allocated by Tivyside Riding Club, to include tack checking and stewarding.

*This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. *All entrants must pay a prelim entry to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above) Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

*All hats must have a visible BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. You must have your hat checked before you ride. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

*Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with the current BRC Handbook. You will need to bring this on the day to be checked before you ride. There is also a checking device on the BRC website.
