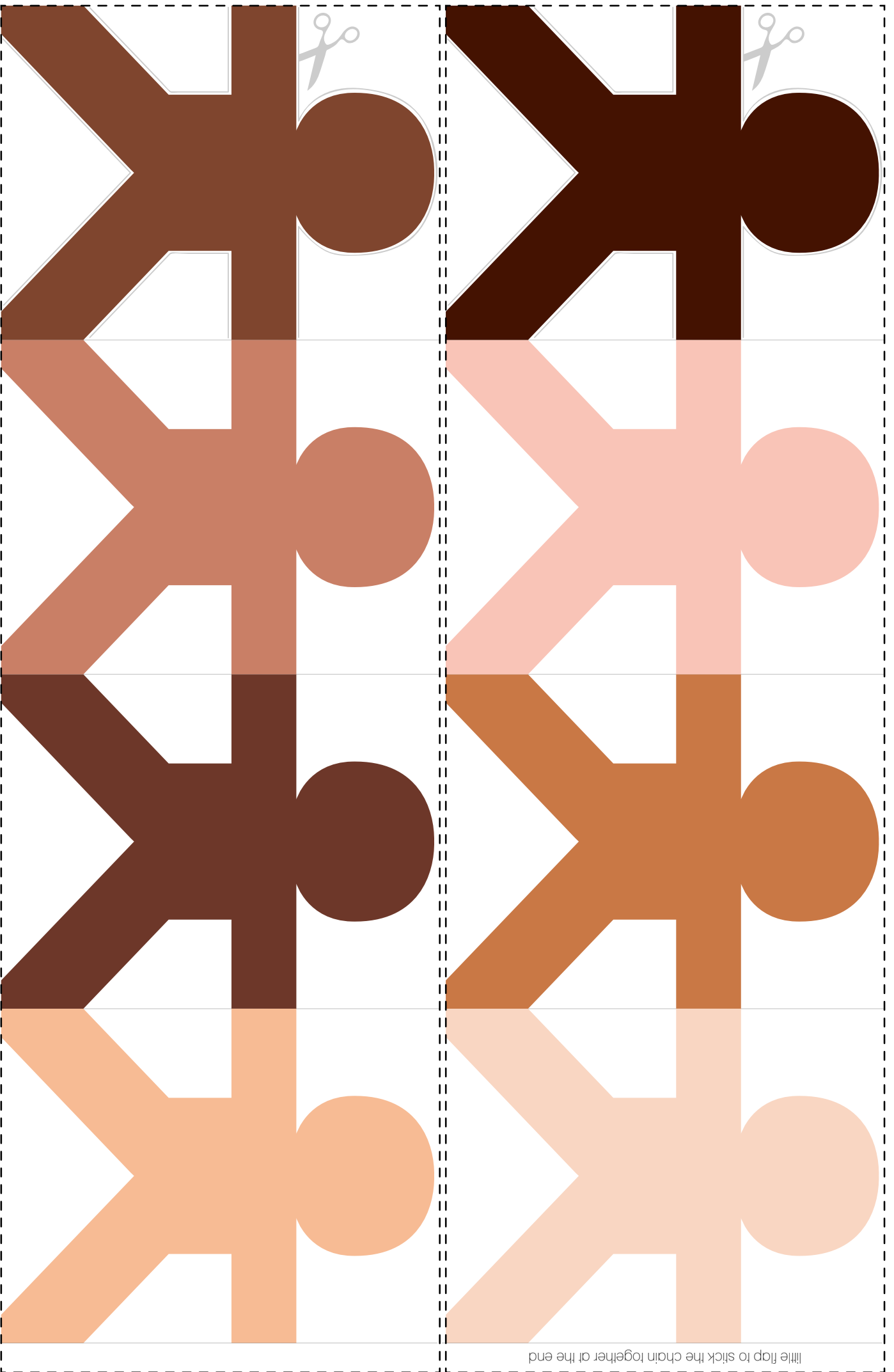
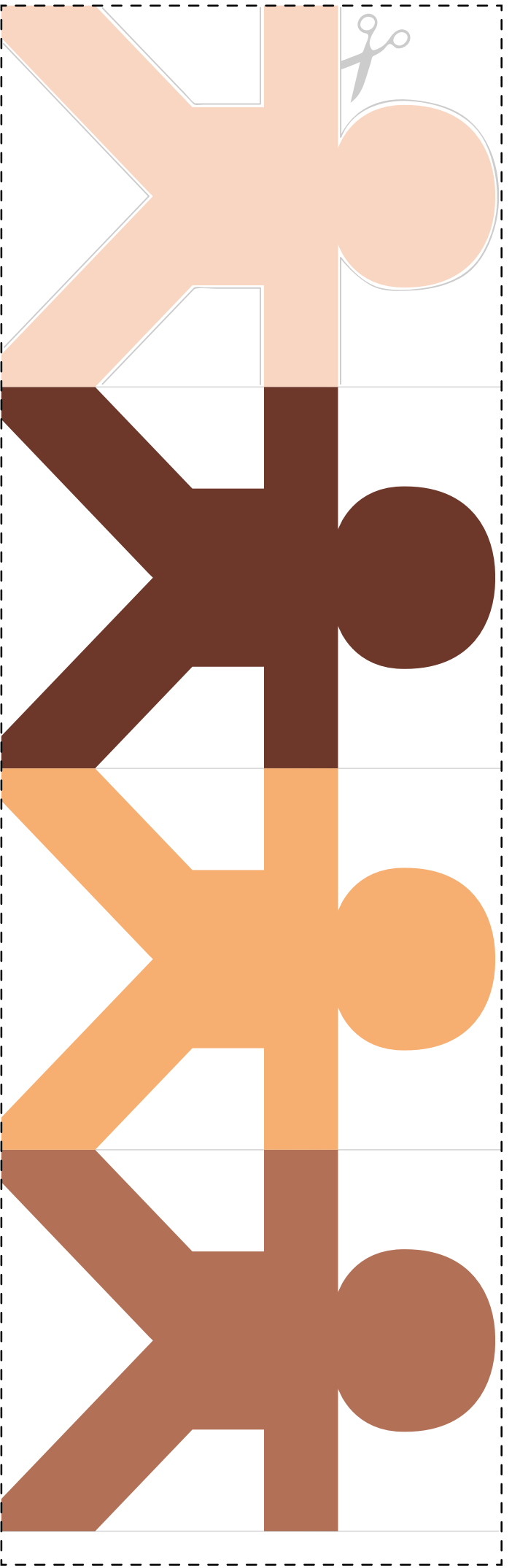


DIY PAPER CHAIN DOLLS



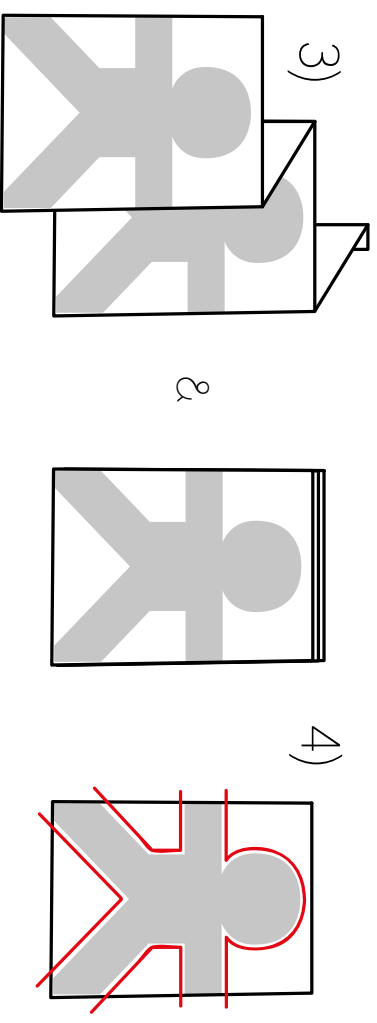
little flap to stick the chain together at the end



DIY PAPER CHAIN DOLLS

- 1) Print onto plain printer paper in colour ink
- you can print lots of times to make a big chain!
- 2) Cut around the dashed outer rectangle lines
- 3) Now fold the rectangle into an accordion fold, squash it flat so there is one doll visible on top
- 4) Cut that top dolls outline out. See red marking in example (you will be cutting through all the dolls at the same time here. Don't cut the edges!)
- 5) Unfold to see your paper doll chain
- 6) Repeat steps 2,3 & 4
- 7) Now you can glue all chains together!
