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**1. APOLOGIES**

Apologies for absence were received on behalf of Councillors J Langan, G K Mockett, K S Green,  
M J Mullins, D A Prynn and G C Rickard.

**2. MINUTES**

**RESOLVED** that Minutes 1 to 4 of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 11 April 2011 be approved as a  
correct record.

**3. COMMUNITY REPORT**

A report from the Town Clerk on the previous six months' activities and future projects was noted.

**4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

A member of the public attended the meeting and congratulated the Council on the refurbishment of  
the Temperance Hall. He raised concerns regarding parking at the top of Brown's Hill and it was noted  
that it was an issue for Cornwall Council's Highways department. Councillor Mrs M K May advised that  
plans were in hand for the introduction of yellow lines on the top of Brown's Hill which should be in  
place by late summer/early autumn. In relation to concerns regarding the bollards at Round Ring  
which had caused more traffic to drive through Bohelland Rise, Councillor Mrs M K May advised that  
Highways were considering removing the bollards, but this was likely to be part of the highways  
improvements to Round Ring, Durgan Lane and Truro Hill on completion of the Strawberry Fields  
development at the end of the year.

Further concerns were raised by Councillors regarding parking on Kernick Road which had been  
reported to the local PCSO and it was noted that contractors continued to park in the Station car park.

There being no further relevant business the meeting was declared closed at 7.20 p.m.
