Councillor Surgeries

Following a decision to reinstate Councillor Surgeries at its January Council meeting, Penryn Town Council will be holding its first Surgery on Thursday 6 March between 2.00 and 4.00 p.m. in Penryn Town Hall. The Council intends to hold four scheduled surgeries a year, to be held at a different times of day to give as many people as possible the opportunity to attend. In addition, ad hoc surgeries can be arranged at other times by appointment only.

The Surgeries will provide a mechanism for residents to meet with Councillors in an informal setting to raise or discuss any concerns regarding Council matters. However, it is also an opportunity to meet Councillors for an informal chat over a cup of tea and find out more about what the Town Council is doing in Penryn and what plans it has for the future.

The first surgery will be attended by the Town Mayor, Councillor Mrs Beverly Hulme, and Councillor Christopher Smith.
