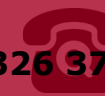

#### Chairman: Councillor C S F Smith

Meets every three weeks. The Council's 'representing' committee. Main focus on development control and submitting informed representational comments to Cornwall Council. Also responds to consultations from third parties and responsible for policy response.
