

Show Rules

1. Penryn Flower, Produce & Craft Show is open to anyone living in Penryn or who attends a Penryn school, or is a member of a Penryn youth or community organisation.
2. All exhibits must have been grown or made by the exhibitor in the last 12 months.
3. Exhibitors may only enter ONCE in each Class.
4. Children's ages on the day of the show must be stated on their entry forms.
5. Exhibitors must provide their own containers, plates, trays, vases, jars etc. Except where stated in the schedule.
6. All exhibits to be displayed at the Temperance Hall by 10.30am on the day of the Show.
7. All fruit and vegetables must be displayed with some stalk or root attached.
8. Onions must have roots trimmed, tops tied down and loose skin removed.
9. Points will be awarded in all classes. 3 for first, 2 for second, 1 for third.
10. The judge's decision will be final.
11. Penryn Town Council will not accept responsibility for any loss, error or damage, but reasonable care will be used to avoid this.

- 5pm: Hall closes

Prizes & Points

The Show is more about taking part than winning prizes. However there will be Certificates and 3 'Best in Show' cash prizes awarded to competitors with the most points overall:

1st £15 2nd £10 3rd £5

3 Children's 'Best in Show' prizes:

1st £10 2nd £5 3rd £3

Points will be awarded in each class:

3 points for a First ~ 2 points for a Second ~ 1 point for a Third
Keep a copy of your entry forms for your records and bring it with you on show day. Photocopies of this entry form are accepted. Please complete a separate form for each person entering.

All entry forms must be received by 9.30am on Monday 24th September 2018. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

You can leave an envelope with your completed Entry Form at the Penryn Council Office reception or you can post your entry form to:

How to take part:

- Decide which Sections and classes you would like to enter, and take note of any special instructions.
- Complete the Entry Form.
- Your entry form must be submitted in advance.
- Grow, make or prepare your exhibits in good time for the Show.
- Take your exhibits to the Temperance Hall between 9am and 10.30am on the morning of the show.
- Report to the Show Reception and we will check your entries and give you your show entry number.
- Find the correct tables for your entries (see Class numbers on tables) and place your entries on the show entry card.
- All exhibits must be in place by 11am, when the hall will close for judging.
- After judging finishes at 1pm the Hall will be re-opened for the general public to view all the exhibits and see who has been successful.
- Presentations will be made at 3.00pm
- Exhibits stay in place until 4pm.
