An elegant palate of ripe black fruit, vanilla and hints of coconut, framed by soft, polished tannins.				
<b>21.</b> Capillo de Barro Malbec	Argentina	£6.70	£9.50	£27.00
Fulsome on the palate, delivering a swathe of ripe, fresh black fruit all held together by lush tannins.				
<b>22.</b> Mozzafiato Primitivo,	Italy			£24.00
Full and voluptuous with aromas of prunes, dates and sweet spice, all rounded off with toasty notes on the finish.				
<b>23.</b> St Désir Pinot Noir	France			£25.00
A gold medal winner, with intense aromas of redcurrant and cherry. The palate is bursting with red fruit flavours and a subtle smoky hint on the finish.				
<b>24.</b> Claro Reserva Carmenere	Chile			£27.00
A big and bold wine that delivers intense flavours of leather, chocolate, figs, dried plums and black pepper.				
<b>25.</b> La Garnacha, Ribera del Duero	Spain			£27.00
Powerful aromas of wild berries and tobacco leaf are tempered by a sense of freshness and floral edges.				
<b>26.</b> Esprit de Lussac, Lussac St-Emilion	Bordeaux, France			£33.00
A rich, full-bodied wine showing great concentration – intense black fruit and a smoky sandalwood character.				
<b>27.</b> Barolo, Natale Verga	Italy			£40.00
An inviting garnet colour, this wine offers a blackberry bouquet, accented with persistent notes of rose petal and subtle wood smoke. A warming palate with undertones of spice and graphite.				
<b>28.</b> The Chocolate Block	Franschhoek, South Africa			£45.00
A South African take on Chateaneuf du Pape, with flavours of black cherry, spice and bramble, resulting in a rich but pleasingly smooth wine.
