### **Persecuted Church update**



Ahok



**Pastor Kholmatov** 

**Ahok**, the capital's first Christian and ethnic minority governor since the 1960s, was arrested during his re-election campaign against a Muslim contender – during which Islamist extremists took to the streets to protest against him.

One day after losing the election, Ahok's prosecutors downgraded the blasphemy charges against him, saying he should not have to serve prison time but the judge still issued a harsh two-year sentence against him, which he is now serving.

In April 2017, Protestant church leader **Pastor Bahrom Kholmatov** was summoned for questioning and then arrested by Tajikistan's National Security Committee. Three months later, he was sentenced to three years' imprisonment which he is now serving. His crime was *'singing extremist songs in church and so inciting religious hatred'*.

The window of opportunity to write to a Christian in North Korea was very small and is now closed. However 2,292 letters are being delivered slowly and safely.

Thank you for praying for persecuted Christians, that they may remain strong in their faith and for their persecutors, that they may encounter Christ and be forever changed.
