God, grant me the serenity to accept the people I cannot change, which is pretty much everyone, since I'm clearly not you, God. At least not the last time I checked.


And while you're at it, God, please give me the courage to change what I need to change about myself, which is frankly a lot, since, once again, I'm not you, which means I'm not perfect.

Be encouraged, churches are being re-opened!




On 12th June 2018 it was reported that three Algerian churches, which had been closed by officials, have been allowed to reopen. Two churches were closed in February, after authorities claimed they did not have state approval. A third church has been closed since November over claims its bookshop had been used to *"illegally print gospels and publications intended for evangelism"*. The governor of Oran signed off on their reopening "without conditions" on June 11th 2018.

Algeria's Ministry of Religious Affairs claimed the churches were sealed off because they did not have approval and therefore did not "meet standards required of a place of worship." (Claims church representatives vehemently denied.)

This week, security services were removing the seals and handing the churches back over to their leaders and the local Christian community.

Please pray that the Algerian Government would be more open towards Christians and allow more churches to be re-opened "without conditions".

Praise the Lord, churches are being rebuilt.



Christians and Muslims reached an agreement on 11th June 2018 to revive the Church of Kokheh in Iraq and make it a place of pilgrimage. The Church, located south of Baghdad is considered to be where Christianity first expanded into Asia, Hopefully, this interfaith agreement will have real consequences that will lead to the church's restoration.

During the meal, the local Muslim community and the visiting Christians agreed to work on a plan together to reconstruct the site with the support of the government and organize tours to the church for Christians in and outside Iraq.

Hallelujah! Christians are being released!


