Rev Yumusa Nmadu was recently elected General Secretary of the Evangelical Church Winning All (ECWA) denomination, one of the largest denominations in Northern Nigeria, with a membership of over 5,000,000 worldwide. He is also head of Christian Solidarity Worldwide in Nigeria and works to promote religious freedom across Nigeria. He is constantly at risk from attack by Fulani herdsmen and Boko Harem.

When **Marta** was very young, her family agreed to give her to the local witchdoctor as servant and wife. She was abused but a family member told her of God's love, and she became a Christian.

In her mid-teens, she left the witchdoctor's house, shared her faith and testimony with her family. All except her father came to faith in Christ. She needs prayer and encouragement to be free from the nightmares of her early experiences.

Pastor Nguyen Trung Ton is an outspoken human rights defender who was kidnapped by 'state agents?' in Feb 2017 and left naked, tied up and with serious knee and lung damage. He was tried on April 5th, 2017, on a charge of attempting to overthrow the state. He was sentenced to 12 years in prison and in July 2018 he was transferred to a prison camp, 1,000 km away from his home.







The joy of giving!

We thank God for inspiring so many people connected with Blaby Baptist Church to support the **Operation Christmas Shoebox 2018 Appeal** which resulted in **60** filled shoeboxes being sent on their journey. Thank you so much.

We now know that our boxes were amongst **66,837** sent to **Belarus**, a country east of Poland, *with "a population of 9,527,543, with 16% under the age of 15"*. In 2018, people in the UK packed an amazing **511,200 shoebox**es.

Natasha (top left) lives in an orphanage. She said *"It was my first gift ever. I knew there were people out there who cared for me. I was not alone. I couldn't believe what I was seeing in my box. There was a doll, a colouring book, crayons, and hair clips. It took me a minute to let it all sink in."*

Jana (top right) lives in very poor conditions. She "proudly showed off her favourite item, a large hairbrush. She jumped around excitedly in her new hat, as she explored every item in her shoebox gift."

"Every shoebox, packed with love and fuelled by prayer, has the potential to impact a child's life in a very special way!"



Our Lord died on Good Friday, But the cross did not destroy His resurrection on Easter morn That fills our hearts with joy.


Now we know our earthly death, Like His, is just a rest. We'll be forever with Him In heaven, where life is best.

So we live our lives for Jesus, Think of Him in all we do. Thank you Saviour; Thank you Lord. Help us love like you!


