"Several queries were made, respected legality for nomination forms, rights of chairmanship method and conduct of voting in each particular they were not proceeded with." The vicar was elected and became Chairman despite only having been in Alne for 3 months.						
(b) 1941. No official election but Jonathan Dunnington died suddenly, Rev Keyes was retiring, George Binns said he couldn't hear any more and Elizabeth Armgill was resigning 'for business reasons'. So William Boldon, the only remaining Councillor, co-opted others as necessary.						
(c) 1934. Four applications were received for the post of Clerk. Harold E. Ryder wanted £6 p.a., Thomas W. Binns wanted £8 p.a., James Hutchinson wanted £7. 10s 0d p.a. and Norman J. Milner wanted £5 p.a. Mr Milner got the position!

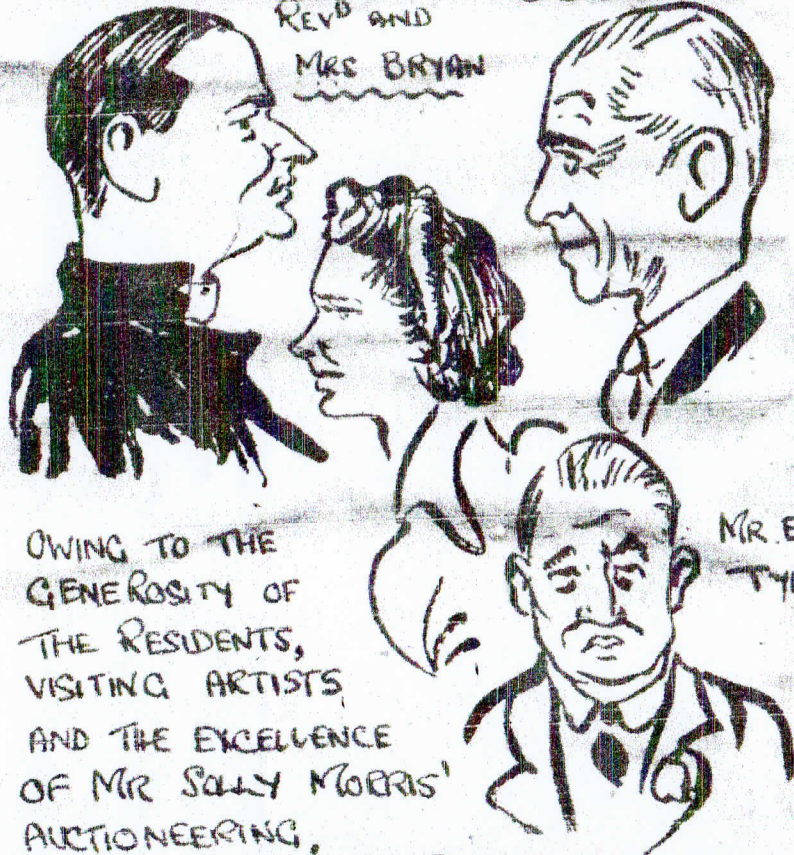

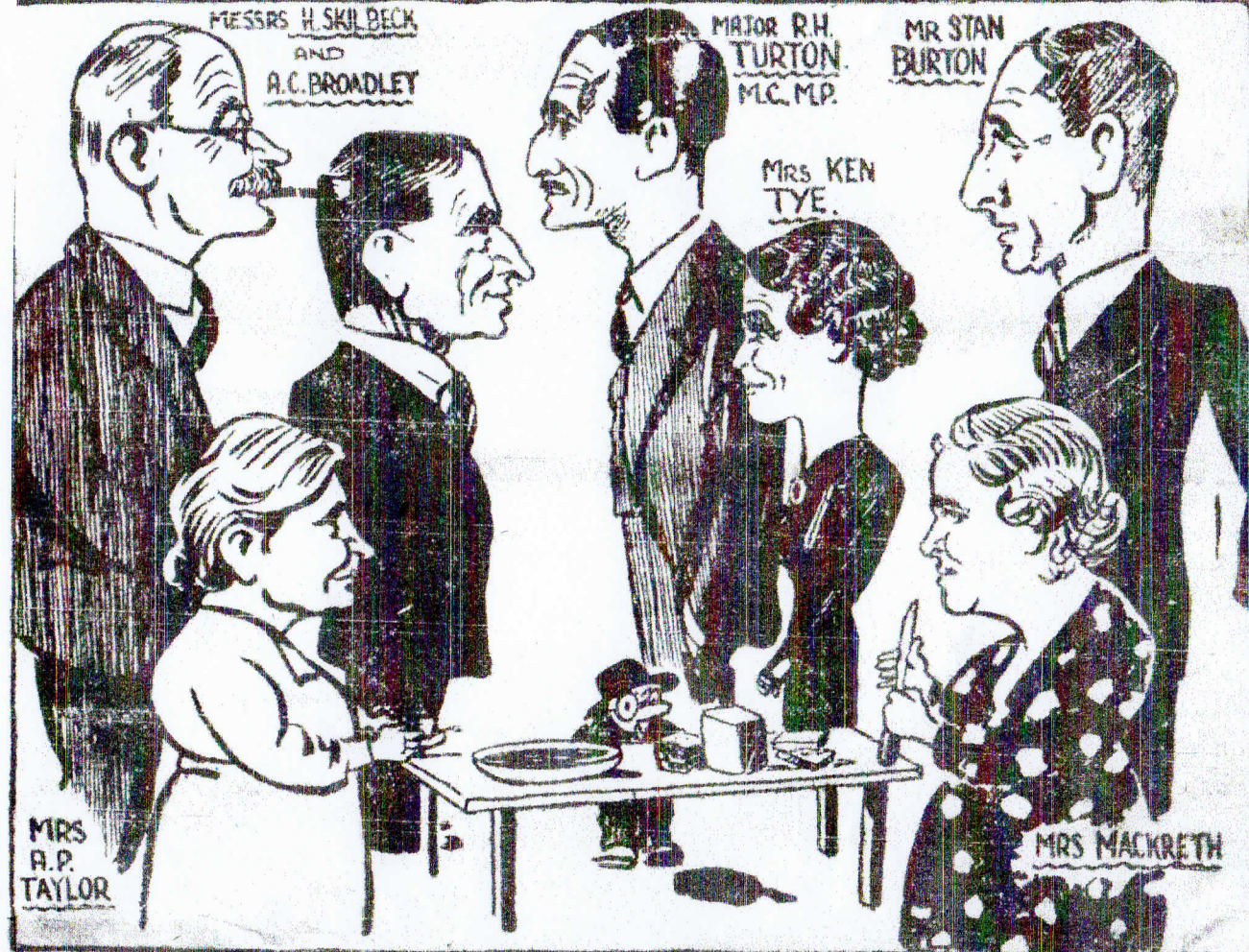
