## Alne Village Website News Archive : 2013

Clare Pelham Chief Executive Officer for Leonard Cheshire Disability joined residents, family, friends, staff; volunteers; neighbours and some of the companies that have helped to get the Sensory Activity Garden project to where we are now. Seen here with Anni Rainbow, one of the residents, the plaque was unveiled to launch the project on 31-July. Thankfully, the rain held off until after the celebrations.

31-July is of special significance to the charity as it is the anniversary of the death of Leonard Cheshire 21 years ago. Leonard Cheshire would be so pleased with this project which is improving the facilities for our residents.

The project was started in March this year when Martin Wintermeyer was asked to take up this massive challenge. He applied to Vodaphone World of Difference who gave him a grant to work in the home for four months. To date we have a garden design by Michael Addis; clearance of debris off the walls by R.A.F Linton on Ouse; trees, bushes cleared by Gerry Kemp; clearance of the whole garden area coordinated by NetWork Rail's Norrie Will with their sub-contractors AMCO, Wrights of Crockey Hill, C.P.M. Strensall, and P&T Contracts. J.N.P carried out the survey of the walls and ESG completed the soil analysis. The plaque was designed and made by joinery specialist Mick & Paul Dowson of Tollerton. Thank you to Jim Wood for allowing us to use his ground for parking the staff cars from June 10th when the work started.

Our thanks go to everyone who has worked so hard to get us to where we are now. Next phase is the technical side - plans to be drawn up and then planning permission has to be gained. We hope this is not too long.
