#### **Requirements:**

Applicants are required to be post-Grade 8 standard and be available for rehearsals on Sunday mornings 9.30 – 12.30 at Bluecoat Academy, as well as concerts. Please see the NSWO website for concert dates.

Applicants should send a short CV by email to [info@nsw.org.uk](mailto:info@nsw.org.uk). Please note that all subsequent correspondence will be via email/telephone therefore please include this information in your application.

Shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an audition to determine their level of competence. This will involve performing an unaccompanied solo piece (approx. 5 mins long) and a sight-reading test to a small panel and sitting in with the orchestra for part of a normal rehearsal on either 30<sup>th</sup> June or 7<sup>th</sup> July.
