Born in Aberdeen, Keiron studied trumpet and keyboard at the Royal Northern College of Music, where he founded the RNCM Light Orchestra and Big Band. He has played with the Scottish National Orchestra, Northern Radio Orchestra, Welsh Opera, Scottish Ballet, London Festival Ballet, Royal Ballet and Manchester Camerata. Keiron has become one of the most experienced and innovative conductors of wind groups in the country, and was appointed musical director of NSWO in January 2006.
