Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, it is not Moses who has given you the bread from heaven, but it is my Father who gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."

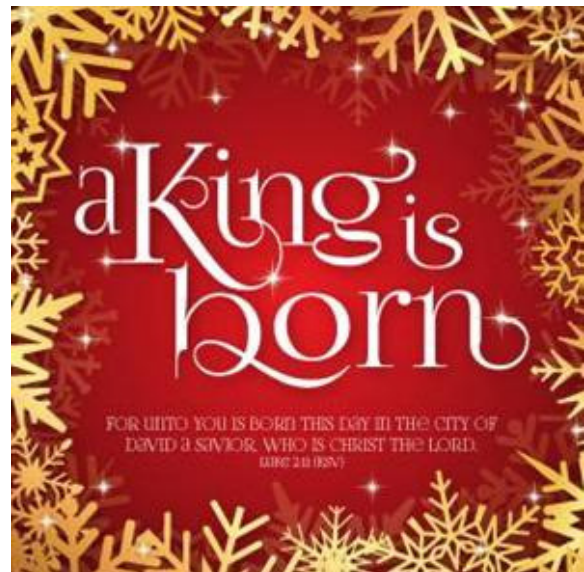
"Sir," they said, "from now on give us this bread." Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty. But as I told you, you have seen me and still you do not believe.

"All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me. And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all that he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day."

At this the Jews began to grumble about him because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven." They said, "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How can he now say, "I came down from heaven?" Stop grumbling among yourselves," Jesus answered. "No-one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day.

"It is written in the Prophets: 'They will all be taught by God. Everyone who listens to the Father and learns from him comes to me. No-one has seen the Father except the one who is from God, only he has seen the Father. I tell you the truth, he who believes has everlasting life. I am the bread of life. Your forefathers ate the manna in the desert, yet they died. But here is the bread that comes down from heaven, which a man may eat and not die. I am the living bread that came down from heaven, which a man may eat and not die. I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live for ever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

Then the Jews began to argue sharply among themselves, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, unless you can eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal

life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Your forefathers ate manna and died, but he who feeds on this bread will live for ever.” He said this while teaching in the synagogue in Capernaum.

On hearing it, many of his disciples said, “This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?” Aware that his disciples were grumbling about this, Jesus said to them, “Does this offend you? What if you see the Son of Man ascend to where he was before! The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you are spirit and they are life. Yet there are some of you who do not believe.”

For Jesus had known from the beginning which of them did not believe and who would betray him. He went on to say, “This is why I told you that no-one can come to me unless the Father has enabled him.” From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him. “You do not want to leave too, do you?” Jesus asked the Twelve.

Simon Peter answered him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God.” Then Jesus replied, “Have I not chosen you, the Twelve? Yet one of you is a devil!” (He meant Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot, who, though one of the Twelve, was later to betray him.)

How rewarding it is to keep focused this Christmastime on the precious plan of salvation for humanity that moved the heart of God to send His Only Son, Jesus Christ into our world.

For millions throughout the world, this present season will dissipate into nothingness. But for countless others celebrating the dawning of world redemption, their hearts will continue to “rejoice greatly” in Immanuel’s coming.

When the shops clear away the surplus Christmas cards and sell off their cheap wrapping paper to quickly parade Valentine cards, the enduring, good news at the heart of Christmas lives on ... and on.

As one Christian preacher said: “You can’t compress into the short season of Christmas a celebration which affects every day of the year for those who have welcomed Christ into their hearts!”

To summarise the miraculous birth of Jesus, the apostle Paul stated: “... God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men’s sins against them.” (2 Cor. 5:19) If this isn’t true it doesn’t matter, but if it is true – as indeed it is – then nothing else matters.

It is deep joy itself to have an opportunity over Christmas to think about the Great Creator becoming our Saviour. What a stupendous event that God was “contracted to a span, incomprehensibly made man”. And all for us – to be brought into a saving knowledge of Himself and receive the gift of eternal life.

What better news is on offer to you and our world today! Even for those of you with schizophrenia who are reading this and have been in prison with the condition for far too long. Knowing the revelation of the love of Jesus Christ for YOU, helps immensely your struggle for freedom.

Because God became man and lived on earth, He knows all you are passing through and every ache in the human heart. He “took upon Him human flesh” and can understand all human emotions. He is also divine and can relate to all you have to face in life. Through Jesus, God can empathise with us – a great comfort indeed at every turn of life. But there’s much more to grasp in understanding the great benefits to us of God becoming a man in lifting up our lives to regain the divine purpose He ordained for us even before the beginning of creation.

I came across a wonderful Christmas meditation by the well-known preacher, Charles Haddon Spurgeon dealing with this point as he focused on the Christ who “for your sakes he became poor.” 2 Corinthians 8: verse 9.

“The Lord Jesus Christ was eternally *rich*, glorious, and exalted; but “though *He was rich*, yet for your sakes He became poor.” As the rich saint cannot be true in his communion with his poor brethren unless of his substance he ministers to their necessities, so (the same rule holding with the head as between the members), it is impossible that our Divine Lord could have had fellowship with us unless He had imparted to us of His own abounding wealth, and had become poor to make us rich.

Had He remained upon His throne of glory, and had we continued in the ruins of the fall without receiving His salvation, communion would have been impossible on both sides. Our position by the fall, apart from the covenant of grace, made it as impossible for fallen man to communicate with God as it is for Belial to be in concord with Christ. In order, therefore, that communion might be compassed, it was necessary that the rich kinsman should bestow his estate upon his poor relatives, that the righteous Saviour should give to His sinning brethren of His own perfection, and that we, the poor and guilty, should receive of his fullness grace for grace; that thus in giving and receiving, the one might descend from the heights, and the other ascend from the depths, and so be able to embrace each other in true and hearty fellowship.

Poverty must be enriched by Him in whom are infinite treasures before it can venture to commune; and guilt must lose itself in imputed and imparted righteousness ere the soul can walk in fellowship with purity. Jesus must clothe His people in His own garments, or He cannot admit them into His palace of glory; and He must wash them in His own blood, or else they will be too defiled for the embrace of His fellowship.

O believer, here is love! For *your sake* the Lord Jesus “became poor” that He might lift you up into communion with Himself.”

Surely, herein lies the secret for every Christian suffering with schizophrenia desirous of breaking free of the bondage – that of knowing communion with Christ. Through His coming, His death and resurrection, His glorious ascension and exaltation, Jesus Christ restored us back into fellowship with the Father. The great enjoyment of life is to have communion throughout each and every day with Christ.

But for many struggling in daily life with the mental bondage of schizophrenia, the real enjoyment of intimacy and communion is difficult. For fellowship to be restored at the deepest level, there needs to see happen the driving out of a presence which is downright demonic. The hearing of voices in your head are totally opposed to the life of God in you and must be defeated at all costs. Jesus will help you get the victory here.

There’s plenty of helpful instruction in the Archive copies of the Weekly Encourager aimed at giving you scriptural support and encouragement in your warfare. Battling through into the freedom of Christ is one of the hardest struggles in life that anyone can face. Do all you can to get the help of other Christians to stand with you and pray for you. Don’t be slow in coming forward for their help. The mighty power of prayer coming from Christians who know the engagement of the light of Jesus against the powers of darkness is most necessary.

As Christmas approaches, take fresh hope and strength that Jesus came into our world for you! He came as the Light of the World so that you may not live in darkness but have the Light of Life. Through living faith in Him, His light and power is released into the human heart. Every trace of spiritual darkness has to be driven out by His mighty power to enforce the victory He came to bring into our world. JOHN CHAPTER 8: Key Verses 12-20: The Validity of Jesus' Testimony:

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." The Pharisees challenged him, "Here you are, appearing as your own witness; your testimony is not valid." Jesus answered, "Even if I testify on my own behalf, my testimony is valid, for I know where I came from and where I am going. But you have no idea where I come from or where I am going. You judge by human standards; I pass judgment on no-one. But if I do judge, my decisions are right, because I am not alone. I stand with the Father who sent me. In your own Law it is written that the testimony of two men is valid. I am one who testifies for myself; my other witness is the one who sent me – the Father." Then they asked him, "Where is your father?" "You do not know me or my Father," Jesus replied. "If you knew me, you would know my Father also." He spoke these words while teaching in the temple area near the place where the offerings were put. Yet no-one seized him, because his time had not yet come.



The spiritual bondage of schizophrenia is like no other. The mystery surrounding it baffles just about every psychiatrist unable to offer a sufferer hope of ever returning to normal life with the kind of freedom each of us is meant to enjoy. No other mental bondage suddenly erupts upon the human mind in late teens or early adulthood as schizophrenia does, nor instantaneously transmits a controlling hold on life as to throw it into a chaotic existence.

I possess no psychiatric training whatsoever that qualifies me to help another schizophrenic. However, the hope and encouragement of coming out of this mental bondage which I am able to offer is the kind others are most eager to know. I seek to magnify the delivering and healing power of Jesus Christ to triumph and defeat what is basically a spiritual problem and not a mental one. He alone can restore to the joy of normal life.

It is most unusual to possess knowledge and revelation about a field of medical science without having trained in that area. I spread real hope of defeating schizophrenia founded in Jesus Christ and based on having come out of the mental illness after 26 crippling years. In the few years of being engaged in the ministry of Praying Until Schizophrenia Heals, desperate cases who had given up hope of ever being free received a new and fresh kind. Little wonder so many still make contact from various parts of the world keen for our scriptural advice to get their loved ones or relatives enjoying the freedom available in Jesus.

As a born-again Christian suffering with schizophrenia, are you really aware who it is living within you? No less a person than God himself. You are not meant to spend your days in spiritual darkness – out of which schizophrenia is born. If the good news about the certainty of being delivered and healed through the power of Jesus Christ has not gripped your life so far, may it do so right now. The life of the Lord Jesus within you is well able to defeat the condition and bring you

into the freedom you are longing to know. Jesus himself said: *"I am the light of the world. Whoever follows will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life."*

The moment Jesus shone himself into your life when you asked forgiveness in his Name, spiritual light came in at the same time. All the words of Jesus you are familiar with are full of light. He himself said that his words were both "spirit and life". Fill your life with his words and you will be filling yourself with his light. They go hand in hand. Satan may know the word of God but he doesn't know the power of it like you know it. The promises of God shining out of your life and being declared from your mouth and heart are enough to unseat the demon of schizophrenia and, any others who have come in too.

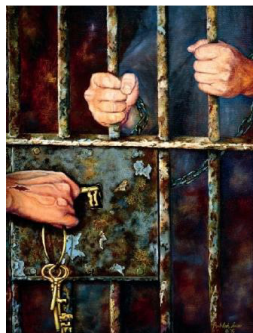
