THIS WEEK'S SELECTED BIBLE READING IS MARK CHAPTER 9: The Healing of a Boy with an Evil Spirit: Key

Verses 14-29: When they came to the other disciples, they saw a large crowd around them and the teachers of the law arguing with them. As soon as all the people saw Jesus, they were overwhelmed with wonder and ran to greet him. "What are you arguing with them about?" he asked. A man in the crowd answered, "Teacher, I brought you my son, who is possessed by a spirit that has robbed him of speech. Whenever it seizes him, it throws him to the ground. He foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth and becomes rigid. I asked your disciples to drive out the spirit, but they could not." "O unbelieving generation," Jesus replied, "how long shall I stay with you? How long shall I put up with you? Bring the boy to me." So they brought him. When the spirit saw Jesus, it immediately threw the boy into a convulsion. He fell to the ground and rolled around, foaming at the mouth. Jesus asked the boy's father, "How long has he been like this?" "From childhood," he answered. "It has often thrown him into fire or water to kill him. But if you can do anything, take pity on us and help us." "If you can?" said Jesus. "Everything is possible for him who believes." Immediately the boy's father exclaimed, "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!" When Jesus saw that a crowd was running to the scene, he rebuked the evil spirit. "You deaf and dumb spirit," he said, "I command you, come out of him and never enter him again." The spirit shrieked, convulsed him violently and came out. The boy looked so much like a corpse that many said, "He's dead." But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him to his feet, and he stood up. After Jesus had gone indoors, his disciples asked him privately, "Why couldn't we drive it out?" He replied, "This kind can come out only by prayer."

It requires a deep level of commitment to remain alongside someone for months, or even years, whose life is in schizophrenic turmoil.

The purpose of this Weekly Encourager is to declare aloud that THERE IS REAL HOPE - on two important fronts:- Firstly, faith in Jesus can fill YOU with hope that He has defeated schizophrenia,

and, secondly, the person you are concerned about can receive hope from YOU of being set free and forever changed.

What confidence have I in announcing that? **TWO WONDERFUL REASONS.** **Firstly**, the SURE PROMISE OF JESUS CHRIST. In Mark's gospel Chapter 11, Jesus says, "Have faith in God. I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours."

These are the words of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. As such they are totally true and reliable. Every promise Jesus makes He is well able to fulfil. Contrary to how circumstances look, if you are holding on to the promised word of God, it will come to pass. God cannot deny His word. You may have professed that you believe God can do anything. But wait a moment. Have you applied that statement to your loved one suffering with schizophrenia? Do you really believe that God possesses the power to defeat the bondage? Or is there a lack of reality between what you say and what you believe?

In our reading quoted at the top of this article, Jesus exposes a lack of faith. There is a lack of faith within the Christian church that schizophrenia CAN BE DEFEATED today. But that does not alter the fact that the power of Jesus is just the same today as it was in the New Testament days. Christ's ability to deliver and heal has not changed one iota because as God He "is the same yesterday and today and for ever" (Hebrews 13:8).

You may have come to the end of yourself in your personal care of a husband or wife, or son or daughter who has suffered with this embroiled condition for longer than you wish to recall. In a cry for help received last week-end, a wife confessed: "I do not know what to do or where to turn. My husband needs supernatural deliverance from demons. I just can't leave him to rot away in an institution without doing everything possible to help." How comforting it would be in her situation for her to know the support and fellowship of other Christians. Prayer and practical help coming from caring hearts would do a great deal in keeping hope alive!

It's easy to understand why human resources get depleted in caring for a loved one who is troubled with schizophrenia. So demanding are the physical, emotional and spiritual challenges over a length of time, that even the best of carers begin to faint. How to keep faith alive that there is a way out for your loved one is no mean achievement. If there is even a germ of faith in Jesus occupying your heart which believes in HIS power to bring healing through deliverance, then keep faith alive - and humbly ask God for more.

Never allow the devil to steal the precious faith you have in the Lord Jesus. The father who had some faith that Jesus could heal his son was desperate to see him delivered and healed. He brought the small amount of faith he had to Jesus and there was sufficient to work on. Jesus used the faith that the man had. Refuse to be discouraged in any way, and don't be dictated to by what your circumstances tell you. Keep faith active, living and conscious in your heart expecting to see a healing of your family member or loved one. Keep calling out to God for His intervention, allow your faith in Jesus to be quickened by the Holy Spirit and so become filled with anticipation that something good and glorious is going to happen!

Yes, there is a way through! Jesus is still able to do the impossible. Keep believing that? The problem in the mind and life of someone suffering schizophrenia can rightly be described as a mountain of a problem to move. But it's not impossible for you to move it with faith in Jesus. Faith CAN move that mountain, says Jesus. Take seriously the words of Jesus concerning proving His power to perform what He has promised - then there's no reason why you shouldn't be able to witness a breakthrough in the life of the person you care for. The words of Jesus are eternally true. You remember, Jesus said: "These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me." (part of John 14:24). When you place your faith in Jesus and claim His promises, the mountains are moved, make no mistake. Keep faith ever-increasing and you will see the mountain sink into a plain.

2. INSPIRING HOPE IN THE ONE YOU ARE TRYING TO HELP: Did you know that because of your confidence in Christ you can impart hope in someone considered to be “a lost cause without hope”. I love to be able to write about this because as someone who suffered with schizophrenia for 26 years, I was inspired to have hope of defeating the bondage by those who loved and prayed for me. Having been free of schizophrenia now for more than 21 years, I ask God to help me send out beacons of hope around the world to those Christians longing to be free.

I mentioned in a recent Weekly Encourager that for more than 22 years, my daily discipline was one of holding on to Jesus in a bid to survive the demonic onslaught on my life. It was only as real hope began to be birthed in my spirit that I moved to a different stance of spiritual warfare to claim my freedom.

Through God bringing my wife Tina into my life, I progressed from “hanging-on to Jesus” and found a desire to want to become free. Hope was implanted in my spirit through Holy-Spirit compassion coming from Tina. Her prayers, and those of her late father Maurice Winterburn and his dear wife, Esther, supported by a group of Christian friends up and down the country, imparted REAL HOPE into my life that I could be free. Hope seemed to come more alive after the time God led me to come off all medication. After surviving a kind-of cold turkey period and the strangeness of managing to live without medication in one form or another, I began to get spiritually stronger and grasp hold of the promises of Jesus.

But don't let me mislead you by saying that it was all easy and a smooth ride to live in those days of preparation for deliverance. My mind had become so entrenched in the condition of schizophrenia that I was in a real bondage. I battled too with a religious spirit and a spirit of suicide. A powerful trio indeed! Not only did I know there was something wrong in my life but I looked as though I was in a prison-house. (see the picture lower down). After changing my job from being a post office clerk working in a demanding job behind the main counter in town, I moved into a less-pressurised office job 13 miles away from home. The light of God's word which I daily read and repeated was beginning to shine into my mind. It says in the Psalms: “The entrance of your word gives light” and spiritual light was beginning to threaten the dark demonic spirits lodged in my mind.

The prayers offered for me were beginning to penetrate the darkness and I was beginning to pray more. A greater confidence in God grew in my heart as the days and months went on. I took over the baton of the prayer warriors supporting me in regular prayer and made a vow at work one day that I would “seek God” in my tea-breaks and dinner breaks until He broke the evil presence in my life.

Right up to the day of deliverance my mind was shackled and fittingly described as the Scripture puts it as having “gates of brass and bars of iron” encircling it. You can't get a more entrenched description than that! I was involved in such a spiritual fight with Jesus by my side that it seemed really unimportant to know that it was “schizophrenia” I suffered from. What really mattered was that I knew there was a power of spiritual darkness seeking to take ownership of my life and I must resist it at all costs and never allow it to overcome me. But out walking on the hills with Tina on Deliverance Day, she just happened to mention that my problem was one of schizophrenia. At the moment, I heard the Holy Spirit whisper in my spirit – “Yes, that is what it is.” In a prayer time that followed, God broke through and assured me that by the end of the time I would be a free man, and I believed it. *(Details of the deliverance and healing can be found in Chapter 9 of “Schizophrenia Defeated” on the website).*

What I am seeking to point out is that through the efforts and prayers of Tina, her father, step-mother and others, HOPE was imparted into my spirit. HOPE BIG ENOUGH TO INSPIRE ME TO WANT TO BE FREE AT ALL COSTS.

Such hope anchored in your life through knowing Jesus Christ as your Saviour can touch a family member or friend who suffers with schizophrenia. Holding on to Jesus, you can offer to do what it

takes to see that person released into the conquering love and power of Jesus. You know that Jesus has already won the victory so are you prepared to labour on in love and strong intercession until you see the chains around their mind completely snapped and the powers of darkness driven out for good. You can be sustained by the power of the grace of God until you have the joy of seeing a breakthrough. As you battle through, you are looking for signs of victory in the person you are helping. You wish to know an authority and power imparted by Jesus scattering the spiritual darkness in His Name and bringing freedom to the captives.

Are you ready to believe that the answer to schizophrenia is found in your Saviour, Jesus Christ? Knowing that Jesus has won this monster of a bondage in the “battle for the mind”, are you ready for a challenge to do all that needs to be done to implement the victory and see your loved one or friend set free?
