The Kenn Centre Management Committee is very pleased to announce that the Solar Energy Installation, at the Centre, is now up and running and generating electricity, and income, for the Centre. We are particularly pleased with the working relationship we enjoyed with our suppliers, Alpha Vae, who have been so helpful throughout the project.

It seems that as soon as one capital project is completed, another one starts. We are now looking to solve the storage problems that Centre users regularly face. The plan is to build another permanent brick-built store in the car park. The designs we have seen so far will enable us to do this without sacrificing any parking spaces. Once again, we shall be seeking grant funding for this project.

Also in the pipe line are improvements to the hearing loop system and the provision of a bespoke PA system for use in meetings, demonstrations, quizzes etc.

Finally, if anyone is interested in joining the Committee, as Treasurer, we shall have a vacancy next year and we'd like to find someone soon so that he or she can have a few months working with Elizabeth Harman, our current Treasurer. There is an honorarium that goes with the post.
