Angelus Facts

The Angelus gets its name from the first word in Latin of the prayer: "Angelus Domini nuntiavit Mariæ." It means "The Angel of the Lord Declared unto Mary"!

The Angelus is a short prayer to remember the Incarnation (When God became man, as Jesus).

It is prayed three times a day, at 6am, 12noon and 6pm

At Eastertide (The period from Easter Sunday to Pentecost) the Angelus is replaced with the Regina Coeli

Every Sunday at midday Pope Francis gives an Angelus Address, where he talks about an important subject and prays the Angelus with the people.

A bell used to be rung throughout the Prayer but now, it is rung before we pray!
