How did it all begin?

Back in 2008 Paul Morris from the Chocolate Café was looking at ways of celebrating Great British chocolate whilst promoting Ramsbottom's impressive number of quality eateries and numerous independent businesses.



With The Chocolate Café and Bury Council as partners, and with support from Ramsbottom Business Group, the idea grew. The first Festival was held in 2009 and consisted of a small chocolate market with just 12 chocolate stalls. From these small beginnings the Ramsbottom Chocolate Festival has grown into an annual two day event, still very much focused on quality chocolate, but with a great family appeal.



While other destinations have tried to replicate it, Ramsbottom remains the home of the original and the best UK chocolate festival offering a truly unique chocolate experience for all the family. In 2012 the Ramsbottom Chocolate Festival was awarded the coveted Manchester Tourism Award for

'Best Small Event'.

Our two day chocolate market takes place on Bridge Street, Silver Street, Square Street, St Paul's Church Gardens and on Market Place in the heart of Ramsbottom. There is much to choose from and even the most enthusiastic chocoholics will be spoilt for choice. There are over


