## Knit and Crochet Hats with Flowers in DK & 4ply

### Tension

It is essential to work to the stated tension in order to achieve the desired fabric and garment size. You should always start by knitting/crocheting a tension square before creating the full garment.

If you have fewer stitches than stated you will need to go down needle/hook sizes until the correct tension is achieved. If you have more, you will need to go up needle/hook sizes. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting the garment.

### Finishing

We recommend using mattress stitch for seaming your hat.

Once your hat is completed it is essential to block your work. Pin your hat out to the size stated in the pattern. Cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

### Tension

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm (4in) over stocking stitch using 4mm needles or size required to give correct tension.

If there are less sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a finer needle. If there are more sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a larger needle. **It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.**

## Note

Models wear Versions Two and Four in Signature 4ply and Versions One and Three in ColourLab DK. You can knit any of the colourways shown in either weight of yarn, however, the colour combinations for this hat are endless – don't be afraid to experiment!

## Hat Version One & Two

**Using 3.25mm needles and C**, cast on 102 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2x2 rib, work 9 rows more.

**Row 12 (WS):** Rib 5, rib2tog, (rib 8, rib2tog) 9 times, rib 5. 92 sts.

**Break off C.**

**Change to 4mm needles and M**, beg with a knit row, working in st-st (throughout) cont until Hat measures 18cm from cast on edge ending with **RS** facing for next row.

## Shape Crown

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, (K2tog, K5) 13 times. 79 sts.

**Row 2 and every foll alt row:** Purl

**Row 3:** K1, (K2tog, K4) 13 times. 66 sts.

**Row 5:** K1, (K2tog, K3) 13 times. 53 sts.

**Row 7:** K1, (K2tog, K2) 13 times. 40 sts.

**Row 9:** K1, (K2tog, K1) 13 times. 27 sts.

**Row 11:** K1, (K2tog) 13 times. 14 sts.

**Row 13:** (K2tog) 7 times. 7 sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

## Flower

**Using 5mm needles and M** for Version One or **C** for Version Two, cast on 18 sts. Beg with a knit row and working in st-st (throughout) work 70 rows.

Cast off.

## Create Flower

With **RS** facing, join cast on and cast off edges, reversing sewing halfway along cast on/off edge (you will now have a seam that is reversed from the centre). With **RS** facing, at centre point of seam, use running stitch all the way around flower along st-st rows and pull tight to gather flower. Fold flower in half onto **WS** and slip stitch at three or four various points to create petals.

## Making Up

Join back seam. Attach Flower to Hat as shown.

Pin out garment to size and leave under a damp cloth and leave to dry.

See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

## Hat Version Three

Using **3.25mm needles and B**, cast on 102 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2x2 rib, work 9 rows more.

**Row 12 (WS):** Rib 5, rib2tog, (rib 8, rib2tog) 9 times, rib 5. 92 sts.

**Break off B.**

**Change to 4mm needles and A**, beg with a knit row, working in st-st (throughout) cont until Hat measures 18cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

## Shape Crown

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, (K2tog, K5) 13 times. 79 sts.

**Row 2 and every foll alt row:** Purl.

**Row 3:** K1, (K2tog, K4) 13 times. 66 sts.

**Row 5:** K1, (K2tog, K3) 13 times. 53 sts.

**Row 7:** K1, (K2tog, K2) 13 times. 40 sts.

**Row 9:** K1, (K2tog, K1) 13 times. 27 sts.

**Row 11:** K1, (K2tog) 13 times. 14 sts.

**Row 13:** (K2tog) 7 times. 7 sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm (4in) over stocking stitch using 3.25mm needles or size required to give correct tension.

If there are less sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a finer needle. If there are more sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a larger needle. **It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.**

## Notes

Models wear Versions Two and Four in Signature 4ply and Versions One and Three in ColourLab DK. You can knit any of the colourways shown in either weight of yarn, however, the colour combinations for this hat are endless – don't be afraid to experiment!

## Hat Version One & Two

**Using 2.75mm needles and C**, cast on 130 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2x2 rib, work 13 rows more.

**Row 16 (WS):** Rib 10, rib2tog, (rib 10, rib2tog) 9 times, rib 10. 120 sts.

**Break off C.**

**Change to 3.25mm needles and M**, beg with a knit row, working in st-st (throughout) cont until Hat measures 16cm, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

### Shape Crown

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, (K2tog, K5) 17 times. 103 sts.

**Row 2 and every alt row:** Purl.

**Row 3:** K1, (K2tog, K4) 17 times. 86 sts.

**Row 5:** K1, (K2tog, K3) 17 times. 69 sts.

**Row 7:** K1, (K2tog, K2) 17 times. 52 sts.

**Row 9:** K1, (K2tog, K1) 17 times. 35 sts.

**Row 11:** K1, (K2tog) 17 times. 18 sts.

**Row 13:** (K2tog) 9 times. 9 sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

## Flower

**Using 4mm needles and M** for Version One or **C** for Version Two, cast on 26sts.

Beg with a knit row and working in st-st (throughout) work 70 rows.

Cast off.

### Create Flower

With **RS** facing, join cast on and cast off edges, reversing sewing halfway along cast on/off edge (you will now have a seam that is reversed from the centre). With **RS** facing, at centre point of seam, use running stitch all the way around flower along st-st rows and pull tight to gather flower. Fold flower in half onto ws and slip stitch at three or four various points to create petals.

### Making Up

Join back seam. Attach Flower to Hat as shown.

Pin out garment to size and leave under a damp cloth for 24 hours.

See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

## Hat Version Three

Using 2.75mm needles and B, cast on 130 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2x2 rib, work 13 rows more.

**Row 16 (WS):** Rib 10, rib2tog, (rib 10, rib2tog) 9 times, rib 10. 120 sts.

**Break off B.**

**Change to 3.25mm needles and A,** beg with a knit row, working in st-st (throughout) cont until Hat measures 16cm, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

### Shape Crown

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, (K2tog, K5) 17 times. 103 sts.

**Row 2 and every alt row:** Purl.

**Row 3:** K1, (K2tog, K4) 17 times. 86 sts.

**Row 5:** K1, (K2tog, K3) 17 times. 69 sts.

**Row 7:** K1, (K2tog, K2) 17 times. 52 sts.

**Row 9:** K1, (K2tog, K1) 17 times. 35 sts.

**Row 11:** K1, (K2tog) 17 times. 18 sts.

**Row 13:** (K2tog) 9 times. 9 sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

If there are less sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a finer hook. If there are more sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a larger hook. **It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.**



ColourLab DK Version Two

## Note

Models wear Versions One and Two in ColourLab DK. You can crochet any of the colourways shown in either weight of yarn, however, the colour combinations for this hat are endless – don't be afraid to experiment!

## Hat Version One & Two

**Using 4mm crochet hook and C**, make 87ch **loosely**.

**Row 1 (RS):** 1tr into 4th ch from hook, 1tr into each ch to end, turn. 85tr.

**Row 2:** 3ch (3ch count as 1tr through), 1tr into each tr to end, turn.

Row 2 sets treble pattern.

Cont in patt (throughout) until Hat measures 4cm, ending with **RS** row facing for next row.

**Break off C, join in M** and work in patt until Hat measures 16cm, ending with **RS** row facing for next row.

### Shape Crown

**Row 1:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 2tr) 21 times, turn. 64tr.

**Row 2:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 1tr) 21 times, turn. 43tr.

**Row 3:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 21 times, turn. 22tr.

**Row 4:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 10 times, 1tr into last tr, turn. 12tr.

**Row 5:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 5 times, 1tr into last tr. 7tr. Fasten off leaving 20cm tail.

Using 20 cm tail gather up through rem 7tr, draw up and fasten off.

### Edging

With **RS** facing, **using 4mm crochet hook, rejoin C** to lower edge and work 1 row of dc evenly round lower edge.

**Next row:** Working from left to right work 1dc into each dc to end. Fasten off.

## Flower

### Small Flowers (make two)

**Using 4mm crochet hook and using M for Version One or C for Version Two**, make 4ch, ss to 1st ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** 2ch (2ch counts as 1dc), work 9dc into ring ss to top of 1st dc. 10dc.

**Round 2:** (Work 12ch, ss into same dc (making loop), ss to next dc) 10 times, ss to base of first 12ch.

**Round 3:** (Work 16dc into 12ch loop, ss into next loop) 12 times.

Fasten off.

### Large Flowers (make two)

**Using 4mm crochet hook and using M for Version One or C for Version Two**, make 4ch, ss to 1st ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** 2ch (2ch counts as 1dc), work 9dc into ring ss to top of 1ch. 10dc.

**Round 2:** 3ch (3ch counts as 1tr), 1tr into same dc 3ch stands, 2tr into every dc, ss to top of 2ch. 20tr.

**Round 3:** (Work 16ch, ss into same tr (making loop), ss to next tr) 20 times, ss to base of first 16ch.

**Round 4:** (Work 20dc into 16ch loop, ss into next loop) 20 times.

Fasten off.

## Making Up

Join back seam. Make a complete flower by sewing the two small and two large flowers together and attach to Hat as illustrated.

Pin out to actual size and leave under a damp cloth and leave to dry.

See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

## Hat Version Three

Using 4mm crochet hook and **B**, make 87ch loosely.

**Row 1 (RS):** 1tr into 4th ch from hook, 1tr into each ch to end, turn. 85tr.

**Row 2:** 3ch (3ch count as 1tr throughout), 1tr into each tr to end, turn.

Row 2 sets treble pattern.

Cont in patt (throughout) until Hat measures 4cm, ending with **RS** row facing for next row.

**Break off B, join in A** and work in patt until Hat measures 16cm, ending with **RS** row facing for next row.

### Shape Crown

**Row 1:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 2tr) 21 times, turn. 64tr.

**Row 2:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 1tr) 21 times, turn. 43tr.

**Row 3:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 21 times, turn. 22tr.

**Row 4:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 10 times, 1tr into last tr, turn. 12tr.

**Row 5:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 5 times, 1tr into last tr. 7tr. Fasten off leaving 20cm tail.

Using 20 cm tail gather up through rem 7tr, draw up and fasten off.

### Edging

With **RS** facing, using 4mm crochet hook **rejoin B** to lower edge and work 1 row of dc evenly round lower edge.

**Next row:** Working from left to right work 1dc into each dc to end. Fasten off.

## Flower

### Small Flowers (make two)

Work as given for Small Flower of Version One and Two using **C**.

### Large Flowers (make two)

Work as given for Large Flower of Version One and Two using **C**.

### Making Up

Join back seam. Make a complete flower by sewing the two small and two large flowers together and attach to Hat as illustrated.

Pin out to actual size and leave under a damp cloth and leave to dry.

See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

## Hat Version Four

Work as given for Version One and Two using **M** only.

## Flowers

### Small Flowers (make four)

Work as given for Small Flower of Version One and Two using **C**.

### Large Flowers (make four)

Work as given for Large Flower of Version One and Two using **C**.

### Making Up

Join back seam. Make two complete flowers by sewing two small and two large flowers together, twice. Attach both to Hat as illustrated.

Pin out to actual size and leave under a damp cloth and leave to dry.

Models wear Versions Three and Four in Signature 4ply. You can crochet any of the colourways shown in either weight of yarn, however, the colour combinations for this hat are endless – don't be afraid to experiment!

## Hat Version One & Two

Using 3.25mm crochet hook and C, make 111ch loosely.

**Row 1 (RS):** 1tr into 3rd ch from hook, 1tr into each ch to end, turn.

**Row 2:** 3ch (3ch count as 1tr throughout), 1tr into each tr to end, turn. 109tr.

Row 2 sets treble pattern.

Cont in patt until Hat measures 4cm, ending with **RS** row facing of next row.

**Break off C, join in M** and proceed in patt until Hat measures 16cm, ending with **RS** row facing of next row.

### Shape Crown

**Row 1:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 3tr) 21 times, tr2tog, 1tr into last st. 87tr.

**Row 2:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 2tr) 21 times, tr2tog into last 2sts. 65tr.

**Row 3:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 1tr) 21 times, 1tr into last st. 44tr.

**Row 4:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 21 times, 1 tr into last tr. 23tr.

**Row 5:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 11 times. 12tr.

**Row 6:** 3ch, (tr3tog) 3 times, tr2tog in last 2 sts. 5tr.  
Fasten off leaving 20cm tail.

Using 20 cm tail gather up through rem 5tr, draw up and fasten off.

### Edging

With **RS** facing, using 3.25mm crochet hook **rejoin C** to lower edge and work 1 row of dc evenly round lower edge.

**Next row:** Working from left to right work 1dc into each dc to end. Fasten off.

## Flower

### Small Flowers (make two)

Using 3.25mm crochet hook and using **M** for Version One or **C** for Version Two make 6ch, ss to 1st ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** 3ch (3ch counts as 1tr), work 11tr into ring ss to top of 2ch. 12tr.

**Round 2:** (Work 12ch, ss into same tr (making loop), ss to next tr) 12 times, ss to base of first 12ch.

**Round 3:** (Work 16dc into 12ch loop, ss into next loop) 12 times.

Fasten off.

### Large Flowers (make two)

Using 3.25mm crochet hook and using **M** for Version One or **C** for Version Two, make 6ch, ss to 1st ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** 3ch (3ch counts as 1tr), work 9tr into ring ss to top of 2ch. 10tr.

**Round 2:** 3ch, 1tr into same tr 2ch stands, 2tr into every tr, ss to top of 2ch. 20tr.

**Round 3:** (Work 16ch, ss into same tr (making loop), ss to next tr) 20 times, ss to base of first 16ch.

**Round 4:** (Work 20dc into 16ch loop, ss into next loop) 20 times.

Fasten off.

## Making Up

Join back seam. Make a complete flower by sewing the two small and two large flowers together and attach to Hat as illustrated.

Pin out to actual size and leave under a damp cloth and leave to dry.

## Hat Version Three

Using **3.25mm crochet hook and B**, make 111ch **loosely**.

**Row 1 (RS):** 1tr into 3rd ch from hook, 1tr into each ch to end, turn.

**Row 2:** 3ch (3ch count as 1tr throughout), 1tr into each tr to end, turn. 109tr.

Row 2 sets treble pattern.

Cont in patt until Hat measures 4cm, ending with **RS** row facing of next row.

**Break off B, join in A** and proceed in patt until Hat measures 16cm, ending with **RS** row facing of next row.

### Shape Crown

**Row 1:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 3tr) 21 times, tr2tog, 1tr into last st. 87tr.

**Row 2:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 2tr) 21 times, tr2tog into last 2sts. 65tr.

**Row 3:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 1tr) 21 times, 1tr into last st. 44tr.

**Row 4:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 21 times, 1 tr into last tr. 23tr.

**Row 5:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 11 times. 12tr.

**Row 6:** 3ch, (tr3tog) 3 times, tr2tog in last 2 sts. 5tr.  
Fasten off leaving 20cm tail.

Using 20 cm tail gather up through rem 5tr, draw up and fasten off.

### Edging

With **RS** facing, **using 3.25mm crochet hook and rejoin B** to lower edge and work 1 row of dc evenly round lower edge.

**Next row:** Working from left to right work 1dc into each dc to end. Fasten off.

## Flower

### Small Flowers (make two)

Work as given for Small Flower of Version One and Two **using C**.

### Large Flowers (make two)

Work as given for Large Flower of Version One and Two **using C**.

### Making Up

Join back seam. Make a complete flower by sewing the two small and two large flowers together and attach to Hat as illustrated.

Pin out to actual size and leave under a damp cloth and leave to dry.

See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

## Hat Version Four

Work as given for Version One and Two **using M only**.

## Flowers

### Small Flowers (make four)

Work as given for Small Flower of Version One and Two **using C**.

### Large Flowers (make four)

Work as given for Large Flower of Version One and Two **using C**.

### Making Up

Join back seam. Make two complete flowers by sewing two small and two large flowers together, twice. Attach both to Hat as illustrated.

Pin out to actual size and leave under a damp cloth and leave to dry.

See ball band for pressing and care instructions.
