

Tendring NHW Report for ECNHWA 15th January 2020

Since the last meeting in November it has been a very quiet period for Tendring Neighbourhood Watch, we think that this was due to the run up to the General Election and of course Christmas and New Year. We held our annual Xmas Social Fish and Chip Supper in December which was well attended.

Our focus has been on recruiting additional street watches and over the festive period we were successful in helping to start a new street watch in Kirby Cross. We have also had a few individual members sign up to Tendring NHW over this period, unfortunately there is no adjacent street watch for them to join at present. Of the leads that Clive Stewart sends us from people joining National Neighbourhood Watch, there seems to be a reluctance on their part to sign up to their local district NHW after they are contacted by ourselves. However we continue to carry on trying to persuade them to join their local district NHW.

We are planning to take part in a Street Action Day alongside Tendring's Safety Community Partnership, Essex Police and Essex Fire and Rescue at the end of this month, January 2020 which is again being held in Jaywick.

We are hoping to get started on developing an online survey, in conjunction with our Community Policing Team, in the next few weeks. As we mentioned in our report in November, this survey is for the residents of Tendring with regards to their thoughts on NHW and what barriers they see to becoming members.
