

REPORT TO ECNHW MEETING MARCH 10<sup>TH</sup> 2020

OVER THE PAST 2 MONTHS TENDRING NHW HAS TAKEN PART IN A STREET ACTION DAY IN JAYWICK ORGANISED BY OUR COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP. WE ARE PLANNING TO ATTEND A COMMUNITY ACTION DAY IN FRINTON WHICH HAS BEEN ORGANISED BY THE COMMUNITY POLICING TEAM AND IS PLANNED FOR APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup>.

WE HAVE RECRUITED ANOTHER 2 STREET WATCH AND WE ARE IN THE PROCESS OF GETTING THEM UP AND RUNNING. WE HAVE HAD ENQUIRIES FROM A COUPLE OF OTHER INTERESTED RESIDENTS BUT WE ARE STILL AWAITING A RESPONSE FROM THEM.

WE NOW HAVE PLANS TO HOLD AN EVENT SIMILAR TO COFFEE WITH COPS AT A VENUE IN HOLLAND ON SEA TO TRY AND RAISE THE PROFILE OF NHW AND MAYBE RECRUIT SOME MORE MEMBERS.

THE LOCAL COMMUNITY POLICING TEAM ARE TO NOW HOLD A MEETING WITH TNHW ONCE A MONTH WITH AT LEAST A SERGEANT AND A PCSO PRESENT AS WELL AS OUR WATCH LIASON OFFICER OR JENNY BROUARD PRESENT. THIS WAS ORGANISED IN RESPONSE TO COMPLAINS FROM OURSELVES TO THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY POLICING TEAM WHO ATTENDED TNHW'S LAST COMMITTEE MEETING IN MARCH.

WE ARE ALSO PLANNING TO ANALYSE THE CRIME REPORTS AND TO ORGANISE A LEAFLET DROP IN AREAS WHERE THERE APPEARS TO BE AN INCREASE IN REPORTED CRIME TO TRY AND RECRUIT MORE STREET WATCHES. WITH THIS IN MIND WE ARE HAVING A NEW LEAFLET DESIGNED AND PRINTED AND SHOULD HAVE THEM IN THE NEXT COUPLE OF WEEKS.

WE HAVE IN FEBRUARY ISSUED A DISCLAIMER ABOUT AN ORGANISATION CALLING IT'S SELF JAYWICK NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH, DESPITE OUR OFFERS TO MEET WITH THEM TO FIND A WAY FORWARD SO THAT THEY MAY BE AN APPROVED SCHEME WITHIN TENDRING NHW WE HAVE RECEIVED NO REPLIES. THE DISCLAIMER HAS BEEN SENT TO ALL OF OUR COORDINATORS AND PARTNER ORGANISATIONS WITHIN TENDRING. WE HAVE ALSO POSTED THE DISCLAIMER TO OUR FACEBOOK PAGE AND WE WILL BE ASKING FOR IT TO BE ADDED TO THE ECNHA WEB SITE.

WE HAVE BEEN APPROACHED BY LITTLE CLACTON PARISH COUNCIL WITH A VIEW TO INTRODUCING NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH INTO LITTLE CLACTON. THE TENDRING NHW VICE CHAIRMAN AND THE SECRETARY ATTENDED A LITTLE CLACTON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING AND GAVE A PRESENTATION ON NHW. WE WILL BE WORKING WITH ONE OF THE PARISH COUNCILLORS TO TRY AND RAISE AN AWARENESS OF NHW AND HOPEFULLY RECRUIT A FEW MORE STREET WATCHES .

OUR AGM IS SCHEDULED FOR THE 16<sup>TH</sup> APRIL AT SAMS HALL IN CLACTON.
